

EXECUTIVE ORDER 040

EXECUTIVE ORDER ENSURING A PLAYER'S RIGHT TO PROTEST IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, there has been much recent debate over a player's right to protest during the National Anthem.

WHEREAS, public schools are a function of the government and should not impede on the right to protest.

I. DEFINITIONS.

(a) "Public school" shall, for the purposes of this Executive Order, be defined as any school administered by the State Government or a Local Government within the State of Great Lakes, including but not limited to public universities, secondary schools, and primary schools.

II. PROTECTING PROTESTING.

- (a) No public school shall prevent the players of its sports teams from standing, kneeling, raising a fist, or making any other legal and non-disruptive gesture during the national anthem.
- (b) No public school shall order the players of its sports teams from standing, kneeling, raising a fist, or making any other legal and non-disruptive gesture during the national anthem.
