

Liability Waiver

Nordkapp Classic Raid IV

By requesting to participate in the Nordkapp Classic Raid, each participant, from the moment of registration:

- **Declares** to be fully aware that, at any time and for any reason related to their own safety—as well as to road and traffic conditions, including construction works, detours, or any other unpredictable circumstances that may occur along the provided route—each crew is free, at its own discretion, to leave the route and rejoin it once such conditions have ceased and safety is again ensured. Participants may therefore deviate from the official route at any time and later rejoin it using alternative roads of their choice.
- **Declares** to be aware that the route may occasionally include short stretches of well-maintained unpaved roads, especially in Scandinavia, inserted solely to avoid heavy traffic sections or roads unsuitable for the event's spirit and purpose. Each participant is always free to avoid unpaved sections by choosing an alternative route at their discretion.
- **Declares** to acknowledge that the organization is not responsible for the maintenance condition of the roads included in the event, nor for any changes to traffic direction or road accessibility that may occur along the provided route.
- **Declares** to have read, understood, and accepted the present Regulations in their entirety.
- **Declares** that, in the case of participation with minors, they agree to sign the parental consent form and release Vespa Club Siena

ASD from any responsibility.

- **Acts as guarantor** of their own behavior during and after the event.
- **Declares** to be in good physical condition and releases the organization from any and all liability for injuries or damages that may occur as a result of their participation in the event.
- **Acknowledges** that the event is a **non-competitive Adventure**.
- **Declares** to be aware that **no medical, food, or mechanical assistance service** is provided by the organizers of the Nordkapp Classic Raid.
- **Declares** to be aware that **no participant recovery service** is provided, except for the optional **breakdown vehicle recovery service at the end of the event**, which can be activated on request and is not included in the registration fee.
- **Declares** to be aware that the organizers are under **no obligation to search for participants or crews** along the route.
- **Declares** to be aware that the organization has **no obligation to supervise or control** the roads traveled by participating crews.
- **Acknowledges** that the **participation fee will not be refunded** under any circumstances.
- **Declares** to be aware of the possibility of encountering **adverse weather and climate conditions**.
- **Acknowledges** that the organizer, *Vespa Club Siena ASD*, is **not a professional organizing entity**, but acts exclusively for recreational and non-profit purposes (as per Civil Code Art. 1174). Therefore, participation in the Nordkapp Classic Raid takes place voluntarily and solely for recreational, non-commercial reasons.

Consequently, *Vespa Club Siena ASD* is exempt from, and in any case released from, any responsibility connected with the Nordkapp Classic Raid Adventure. The Club is also released from any liability for events that may occur to crews during the Raid, such as accidents, loss of route, physical issues, crashes, thefts, etc. The Nordkapp Classic Raid Adventure is therefore to be understood as a **spontaneous, independent gathering** of Vespa riders and motorcycle owners engaging in a free and personal journey.

- **Declares** that, therefore, any participant in the Nordkapp Classic Raid Adventure **waives the right to take any legal action**, on any grounds, against *Vespa Club Siena ASD*, acknowledging that it is a non-professional association operating solely for recreational purposes (as per Art. 1174 of the Civil Code).
- **Acknowledges** that the event's trademarks and materials are protected by copyright, both through **EUIPO international registration** and **Italian national patent**, and therefore **cannot be reproduced or modified** without prior written authorization from the organizer.
- **Gives consent** to the use of their personal data, including for commercial purposes, in accordance with the Italian Privacy Code (Legislative Decree 196/2003) and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR 2017/679).
- **Grants** the organizers full and unrestricted permission to use, within the limits of applicable law and including for profit, any video or photographic images taken during the event, authorizing the organization to transfer such images to third parties.
- **Acknowledges** that the authorization to use their image is given **without time limits and with worldwide territorial validity**, for use in publications and audiovisual materials, including but not limited to promotional and advertising content in any format. The organization may also assign usage rights to third parties,

institutional partners, or commercial partners.

- **The organization declines all responsibility**, both for itself and for its collaborators, for any accidents or damages to persons or property that may occur before, during, or after the event, or as a consequence thereof.
