

## **Retaking Assessments**

- Students are permitted to retake any major assessment they scored below a 70%.
- In order to qualify for a re-take, students must complete the following:
  - Sign-up and attend at least one tutorial
  - Complete tests corrections for items missed on the exam explaining the correct answer
  - Meet with Mr. Johnson to schedule time and date to complete the re-take within one week from receiving initial score.
- All retakes are at the teacher discretion.

- You may earn up to an 70% on the new assessment.

## **Tutorials**

#### **Homework**

# Late/Missed Work

- Late work, as with all assignments, is due at the beginning of class; late assignments turned in after class will be counted as being submitted the next day.
- 10 Points will be deducted for each day the work is late.
   After 5 days the assignment will no longer be accepted.
- If a student is absent on the day the assignment is assigned, he/she will have the number of days absent to turn in the work without a late work penalty. If a student is present on the day the assignment is assigned but is absent on the day the assignment is due, then the assignment is due the day immediately upon returning to class.
