The ESOL program at North Broward Preparatory School is committed to improving students' writing, speaking, reading and listening skills in the English language. It is dedicated to providing a curriculum that will allow students to have the confidence and the language to be successful within the North Broward Preparatory Community, and beyond. The program provides language support for grades 6-12, and delivers intensive instruction with the courses offered. There are 4 possible levels that students can place into, which is determined by an assessment given on their arrival. Students are then placed in specific courses based on their proficiency levels. Students are tested three times during the academic year giving them an opportunity to move to the next level. In order to ensure the success of our English Language Learners, ESOL classes are tailored to the needs and levels of the students, and instruction is delivered that satisfies the cultural needs of the ESOL students, as well as promotes an appreciation of different cultures.

Each class follows a rigorous curriculum that enables active participation, student-centered learning and community involvement. The goal of the ESOL program is to allow students to become competitive in the academic realm, and ultimately, set them up for success at the university level and beyond.
