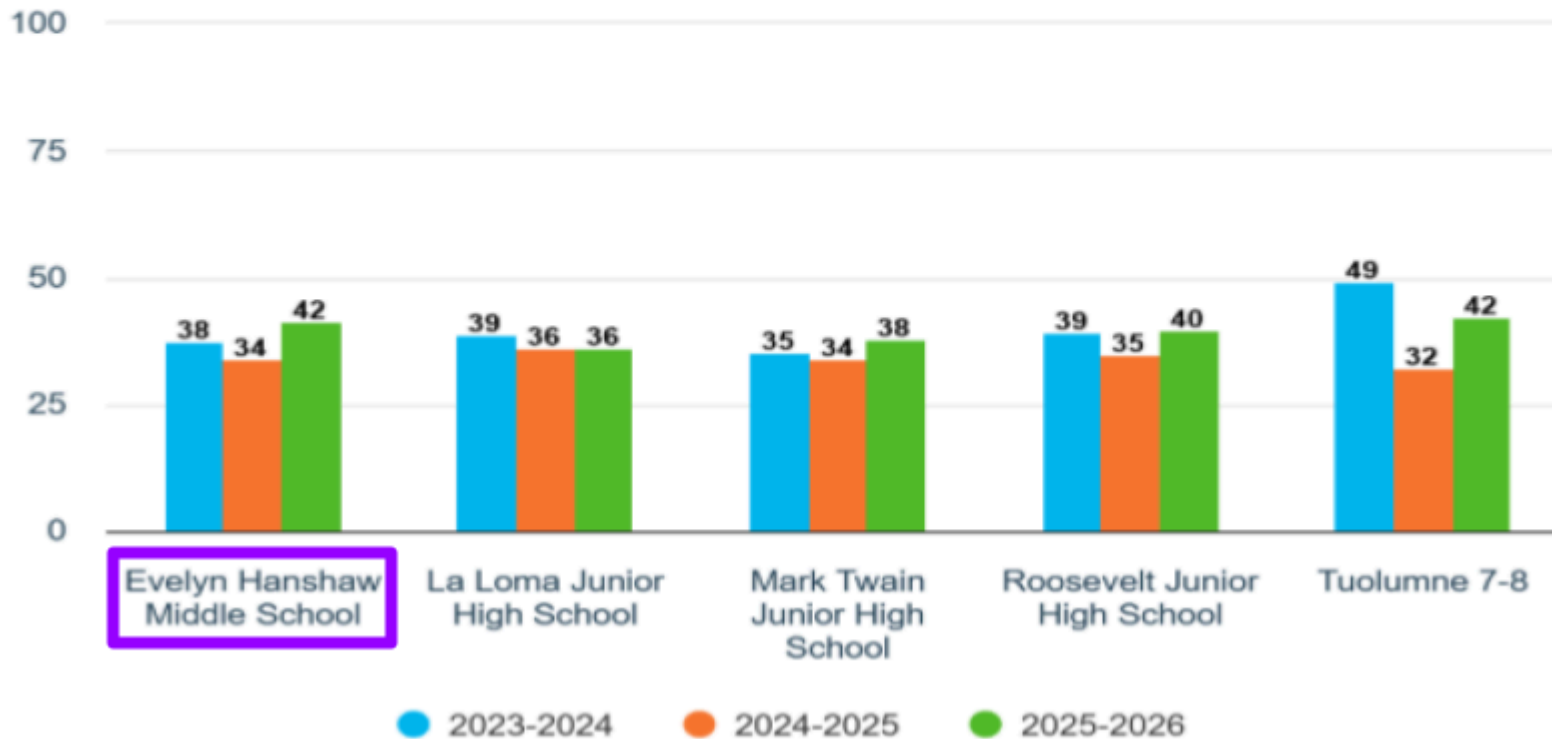

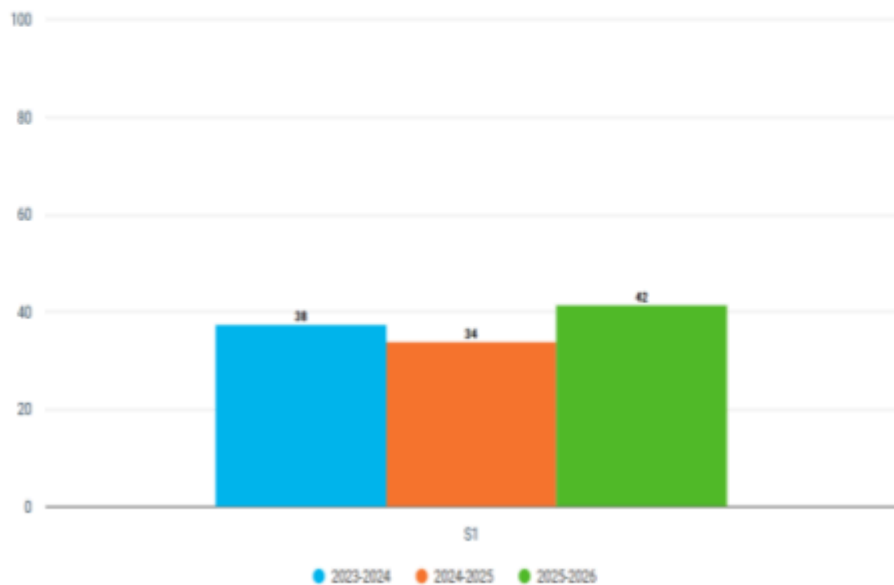

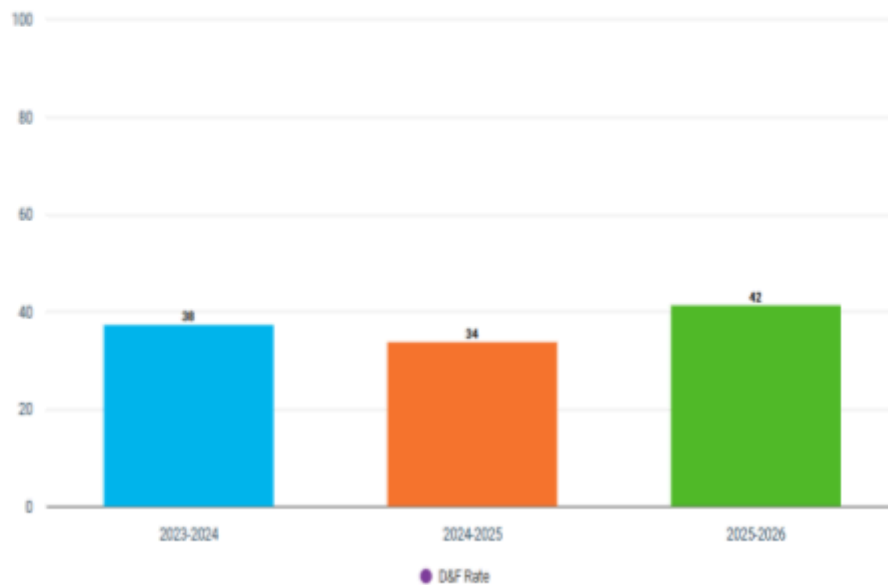

D/F Student Rate by Term



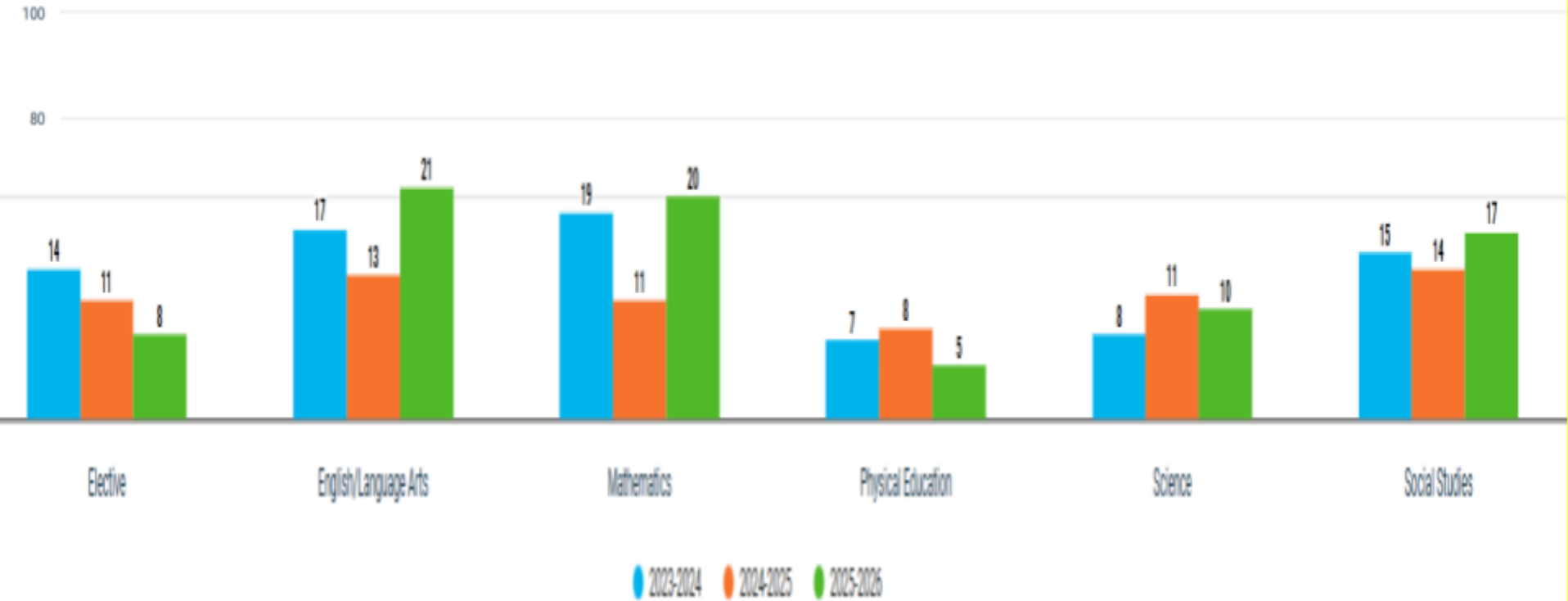
D/F Student Rate by Year

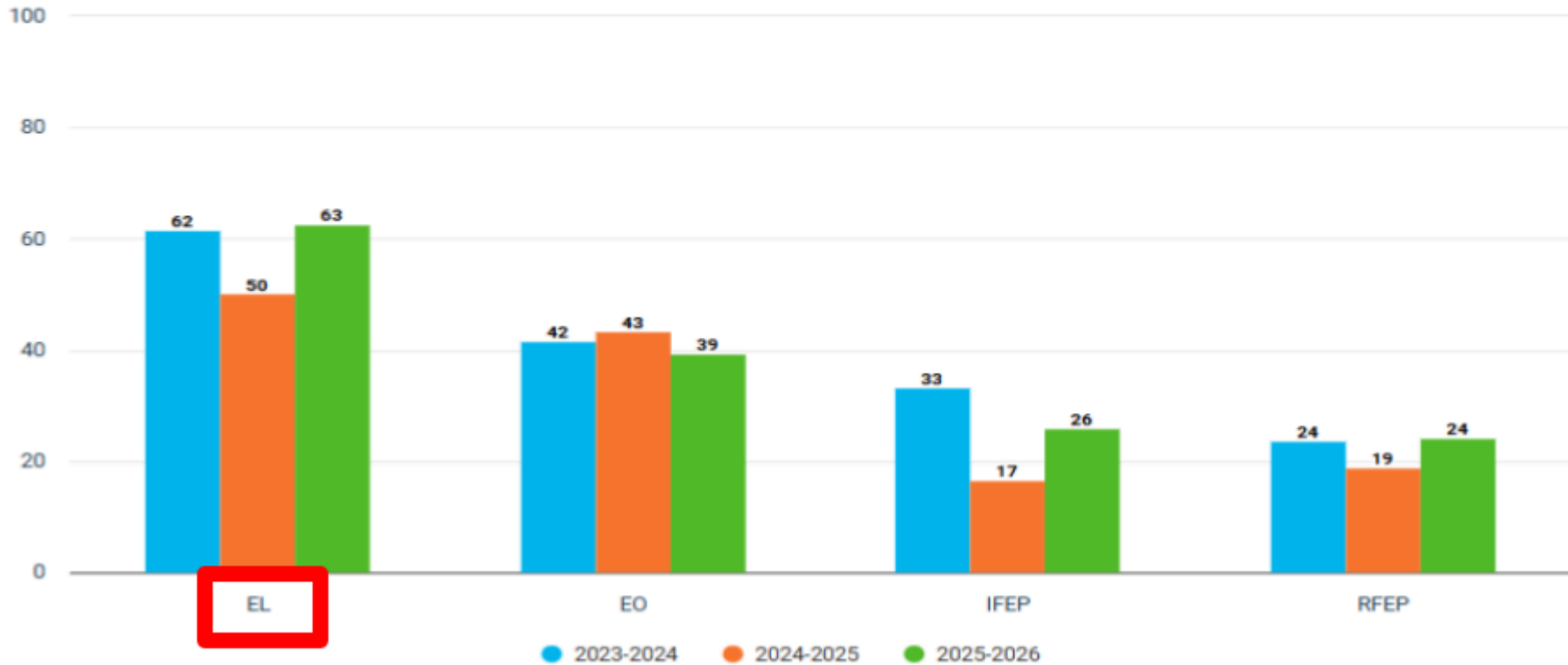
D/F Student Rate by Subject

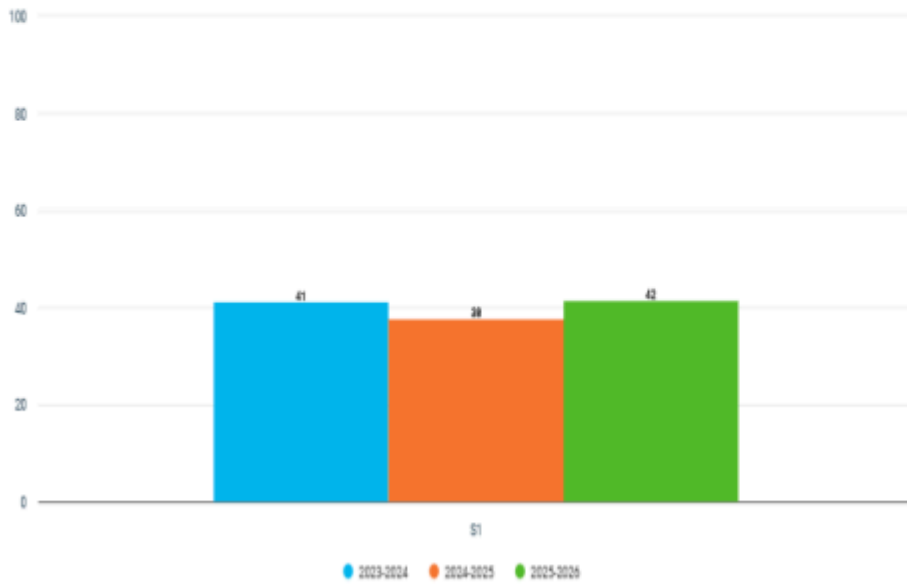

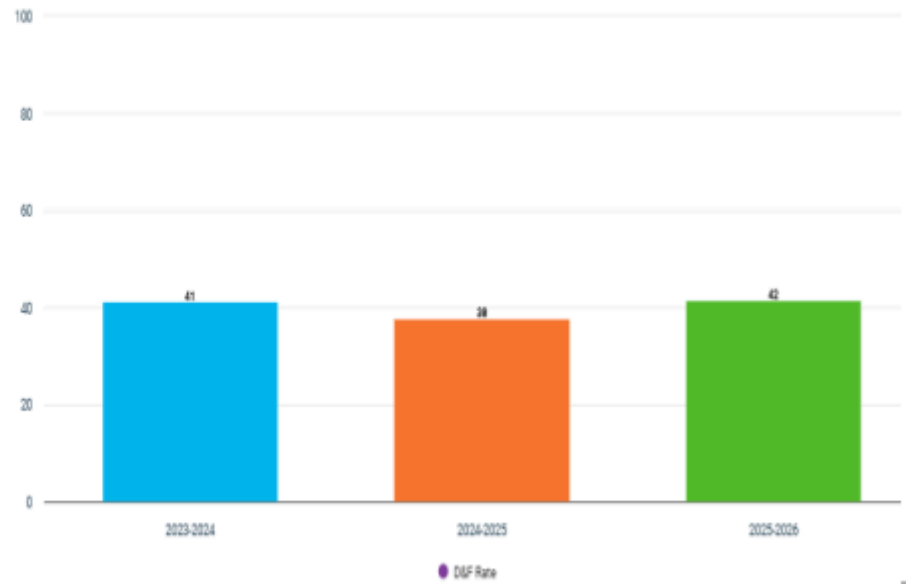

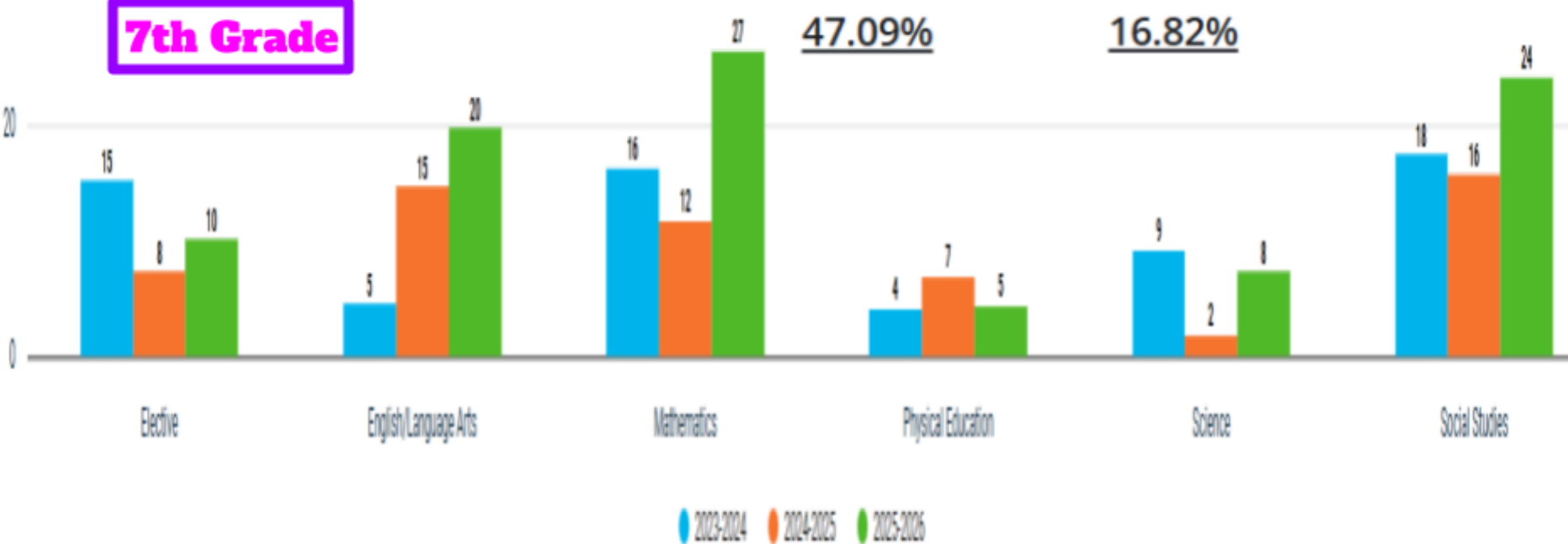

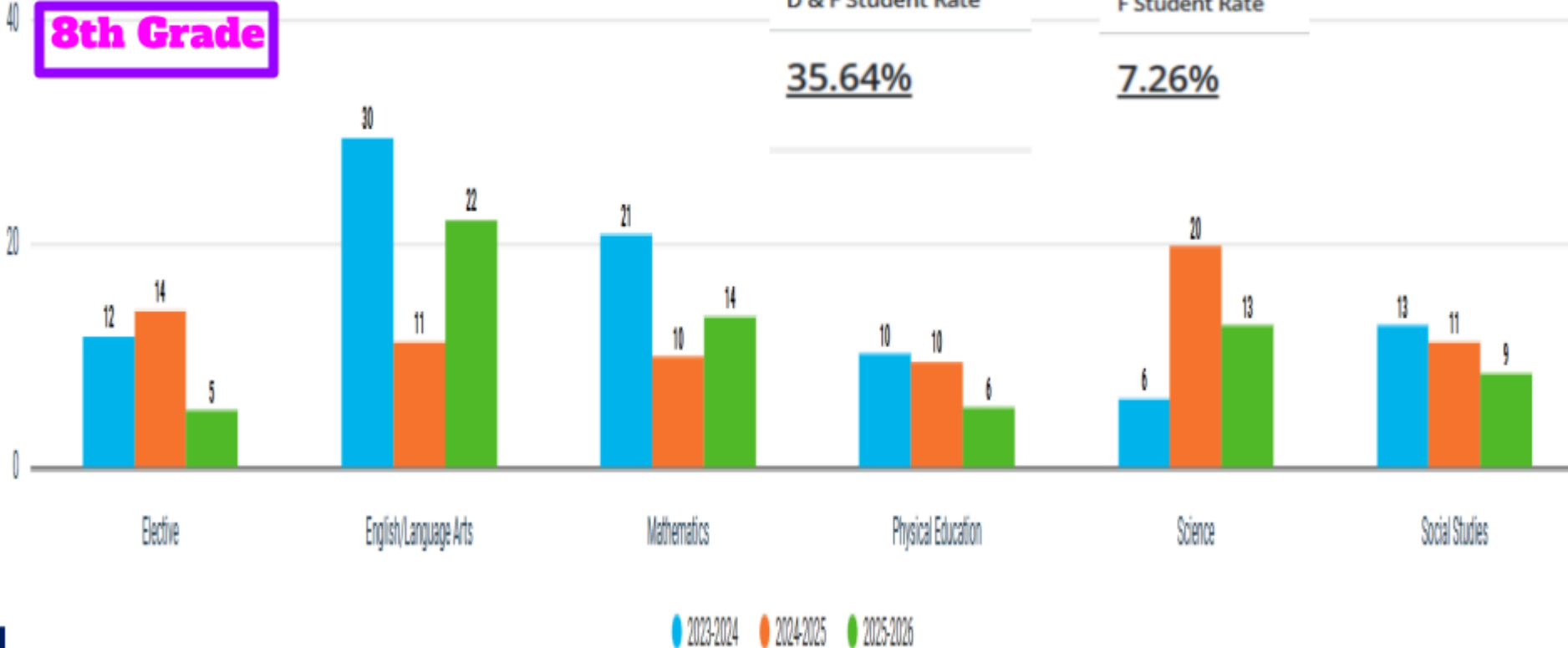

State Achievement: Reading & Literature



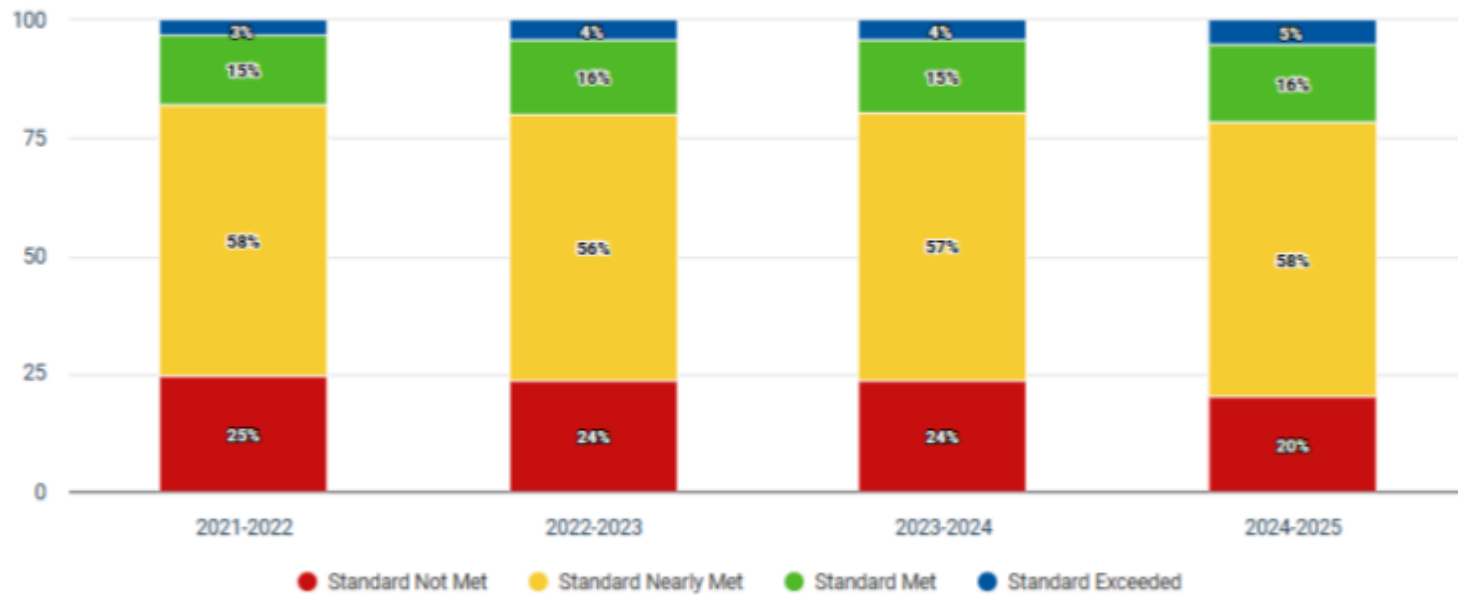
State Achievement: Mathematics
