

Born: 1976 in Arawa, Papua New Guinea **Lives and Works:** London, United Kingdom

Australian-born artist Matt Jukes creates abstract monoprints of forgotten landscapes and misremembered places. Entwined with the idea of memory, Matt's artworks expose the layering of his process-led style. The relationship between planes of land and sky and the depth of distance make for minimalistic pieces of art that capture the haziness of memories. Matt's work is both meditative and nostalgic, he reimagines landscapes through an emotional response and transforms them into something far off yet evocative and familiar.

Through the exploration of colour and texture, Matt's work takes the viewer on a journey, one that acts as a conduit to the exploration of their own relationship to emotion and memory. Capturing misremembered landscapes from obscured memories, viewers are invited to share the emotions embedded in each piece - embracing their own reflections and creating personal memories that contribute to the wider context of Matt's body of work.

Matt Jukes' Process

The arrangement of colour and colour theory is integral to Matt's work. For Matt, colour is a means of expressing emotion, so the choice of colour is crucial to his process. Starting each piece with a search for colour, Matt mixes inks together, and in doing so new emotions arise. Due to the scale of his work, Matt's monoprints are often confused with screenprints. Working on a 200-year-old flatbed lithographic press, Matt repeats his process to build up layer upon layer and creates textures that result in prints that resemble paintings.
