SAT School Day

TBA; NNPS is covering the cost for all 11th-grade students to take the test, roughly \$60 per student. Please note that there will be no make-up date for this assessment.

The SAT is a standardized, computer-based exam commonly used for undergraduate college admissions in the United States and some international institutions. Administered by the College Board, it measures students' skills in reading, writing, and mathematics to assess college readiness, with total scores ranging from 400 to 1600.
