
## JAX TERRY (they/them)

Jax Terry is an actor, singer, filmmaker, producer, and voiceover artist based in Brooklyn, NY. <u>ACTING REEL</u> <u>SINGING REEL</u>



Jax's extensive work in the New York Theatre spans plays and musicals with companies such as Playwright's Realm, Theater Row, Provincetown Playhouse, Pipeline Theatre Company, Firebone Theatre, Forager Theater Company, FringeNYC, NYMF and many more. Most recently, Jax starred as Austin Dickinson in Amas Musical's production of *Show Me Eternity*, a new musical that explores Emily Dickinson's queerness. Regionally, Jax has performed at Williamstown (*June Moon* and *The Taming of the Shrew*), North Shore Music Theatre, Sharon Playhouse, as well playing the title character in the national tour of *Curious George* (dir. Zi Alikhan, Marcia Milgrim Dodge). Jax was also seen in both NCL's production of *Jersey Boys* as the Frankie Valli cover (performed). They have also been seen around the concert/cabaret

scene at 54 Below, Don't Tell Mama, and Town Hall, as well as The Beacon Theatre, Yankee Stadium, and the Theatre at Madison Square Garden. Their own solo show at GreenRoom42 can be seen in full on their YouTube Channel.

On screen, Jax can be seen in shorts and features from Factory 25, Omnes Films, Post Closet Features, Supereon Films, and more. Recently, they starred in "Momento Mori" for the Film Force collective, which is run by Tribeca's Senior Film Programmer Jose Rodriguez. Jax has also appeared on *The Marvelous Mrs. Maisel* and in sketches for outlets such as AVbyte (1M subscribers), and LogoTV (*HomoSapien*).

As a voiceover artist, they most recently stepped in as Cole Escola's voice double for Cole's character, Goldie, on an episode of *Baby Shark's Big Show*. They can also be heard on Nickelodeon Jr (*Nella*), Disney Jr (*Lights Camera Lexi*) and in multiple ad spots for HBO (*We're Here, Somebody Somewhere*). Jax is a staff VO artist for all *English Egg* content. As a singing recording artist, Jax has lent their talents to various albums, musical podcasts, as well as frequent demo singing for the BMI musical theater writers.

As a creator in their own right, Jax wrote, directed, and starred in their debut short film *The Invite* (15 festivals, 5 awards) now streaming for free on <u>Tiny Scripted</u>. They went on to serve as Associate Producer for IFC Films' *Christmas Eve in Miller's Point* starring Michael Cera (AppleTV, Prime, AMC+). Jax also directs music videos (Camp Bedford, Hayley Siano), and is a frequent collaborator with Keep Or Destroy production company (*Duolingo*, *The Neighborhood Guys*). Jax's writing was published in a NYT Bestselling anthology from Lady Gaga's Born This Way Foundation entitled "Channel Kindness".

Jax is a founding member of the nonprofit <u>The Queer Ensemble</u> where they serve on the board and creative produce many new works current and upcoming (Shakina's *5&Dime*, Gage Tarlton's *VHS*, upcoming: Justin Tranter's *Lavender's*).
