About Braver Network

Braver Network is a free, voluntary network of organizations across the political spectrum working together to bridge the partisan divide. We’re committed to equal representation of reds and blues in the network, strong representation of independents and non-partisan groups, and a mix of national and community organizations. No one will ask for money. There are no required meetings. The only requirements are that organizations designate someone from their team to serve as a liaison to the network and that they allow us to list their organization as part of the Network on our website. The rest is up to the organization.

As a part of the Network, organizations can provide opportunities for their members to revive and strengthen bonds of trust across differences. And we’re inviting them to bring their unique and varied strengths to the cause as well—especially by attending our National Convention (June 27-29, Kenosha WI) where, collectively, we’ll be able to create new coalitions and collaborations to transform our national culture.

About the Role of the Representative

The Braver Network team, in an effort to maximize its reach and effectiveness, is seeking Braver Angels members to volunteer as Representatives (or “Rep”).

As a Rep, your role will be to establish a relationship with one or more “Leads” (that is, prospective organizations in the Network)—clarifying the purpose of the Network, ways to participate in the Network, how to join, answering questions.

Once the Lead has joined Network, you will be the first point of contact for them, and your role will be to develop our relationship with this organization so that we can help them build their capacity to depolarize their organization and the communities they serve. We help them build capacity by providing opportunities for organizations to engage key members of their teams in leadership training, including training in organizing and delivering presentations, workshops, and other bridge-building and depolarization activities.

This represents a key means through which Braver Angels will accelerate and scale our reach and impact.

As you communicate with your Lead(s) and/or organizations that are already part of the Network, you can coordinate your efforts with the Braver Network team and communicate with the team as needed.

What are the responsibilities of the Organizations in the Network?

Each organization designates someone to serve as their Liaison to the Braver Network team.

What does the Liaison do?

The Liaison is the person within each organization who communicates with the Rep and connects their organization's members to Braver Angels resources and programs. The Liaison will receive our digital newsletters outlining upcoming opportunities and will be invited to attend quarterly, one-hour, online gatherings to share information and discuss key topics.

Are there any fees, payments, or required meetings?
