- \$20 pays for local, state, & national membership for the whole year; price goes up to \$25 on Nov 1 and \$30 on Jan 1. Dues include a club t-shirt! Pay by **cash** or **check payable to CPHS**!
- All classes with 100% membership win a donut or pizza party! Please place money in an envelope and then
 into the money box in a Latin room. Envelopes are available in the Latin rooms. Envelope needs name, what
 you are paying for (e.g. Latin Club dues), amount, and date
 - As of right now we have 45 members. 4th year has 100%, seventh hour of 1st year has 66%, 3rd year has 50%, 2nd year has 36.4%, and third hour of 1st year has 32%.
 - Once you've paid your dues, you can use your account money to pay for other Latin events.

• World Language Department Poinsettia Fundraiser

- The poinsettia fundraiser started on October 2. All forms and money must be turned in by October 13.
- These plants come in foil-wrapped 6.5" pots, are available in <u>four different colors</u>, and cost \$13.00 each; checks should be made payable to CPHS.
- Students selling plants need to pick up their orders on Wednesday, November 29, in the SGI between 2:45 and 5:00 and then deliver them to their customers; they cannot stay out in the cold!
- All money raised by Latin students will be used to offset the costs of AP Latin tests and Latin travel programs like the Italy trip or National Convention.
- Non-AP students must sell at least 2 plants to qualify for travel grant money.
- AP students must sell at least 2 poinsettias to receive subsidies for their AP Latin test. AP students who sell at least 4 poinsettias may receive money both for their AP Latin test and a travel grant.
