Changes to Athens Public Transit (APT) Line 7 A & N

ATHENS, OH - Effective Monday, October 30th, Athens Public Transit (a HAPCAP program) Line 7, which runs to Nelsonville and Albany, will adjust their stop times by 15 minutes. This change in time will allow riders direct connection to Line 3 and Line 6, creating easier access to East State Street, The Plains, and Chauncey.

Line 7 will begin running at 7 a.m. from the Ohio University Baker Center and last drop off at 7 p.m. at Baker Center.
