- Principal's Report & Q&A Shawn Kuennen
 - School's off to a smooth start
 - Please note the new drop off procedure. Thank you to parents for helping!
 - Illness-please follow guidelines: Please keep children home for fever and vomiting. Keep home 24 hours after vomiting and 24 hours after fever break (without medication)
 - o Enrollment:
 - Largest class in building is 23 students, which is the average we're seeking campus-wide
 - 397 students at JRES
 - DLI staffed 25:1 historically to accommodate student atrophy
 - Cap dropped to 23 because we really haven't seen atrophy
 - First grade DLI has two classes of 22 students
 - Funding request: PTO stipend for afterschool staff to cover Corner Cafe at lunch
 - Katie Hedman new Student Services Dean, so she is unable to staff Corner Cafe daily
 - Corner Cafe is hard to staff right now
 - Part of the Positive behavior incentive program, required by state, (Dojo) system
 - Students love this!
 - o Intervention Team: Fully staffed
 - Caroline Alberts added to the team!
 - Curriculum for reading has changed; Tier system called 95%
 - Amazing program, but needs to be put together and it is time intensive to put into nice binders
 - Asking for volunteers to assemble binders. Need to be completed by Sept. 19th
 - Asking for PTO sponsorship for lunch during testing week.

 - Teacher Gifts
 - Limit: Staff cannot accept gifts greater than \$50.
 - Whole class gift has to be less than \$50, too, but will confirm this.
