During the campout we will be working on Rank Requirements and Scouting Skills, any related material is in your Scout Handbook and should be read and carefully studied. **Please bring your handbook to the campout.**

- ☐ Extra rain fly
- ☐ Rope/Paracord

Clothing

- ☐ Poncho or raincoat
- ☐ Warm jacket /fleece
- ☐ Pajamas or sweatshirt and sweatpants
- ☐ Underwear and Socks (and extras)
- ☐ Durable closed toed shoes (hiking boots, sneakers)
- ☐ Ball cap
- ☐ Winter hat
- ☐ Gloves
- ☐ Snow Pants and Winter Boots
- ☐ Clothing designed for the weather

Toilet Kit

- ☐ Toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss
- ☐ Comb or brush
- ☐ Deodorant
- ☐ Soap in a container
- ☐ Washcloth and towel
- ☐ Toilet paper
- ☐ Shampoo
- ☐ Towel

First Aid and Essentials

- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Filled Water Bottle
- ☐ Flashlight with extra batteries
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Insect repellent
- ☐ Whistle
- ☐ Scout Handbook
- ☐ 10 scout essentials

Extras

- ☐ Day Backpack
- ☐ Camp chair
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Notebook and writing utensil
- ☐ Battery Powered Alarm Clock
