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**Summer Learning** - There are three summer learning opportunities we are exploring for this summer (up to 10 hours total/paid at \$25 per hour - between June 13- August 5, 2022 - unless otherwise noted). These 10 hours can be used in combination in any format, but can not exceed 10 hours.

**Option 1: Guided Focus Group:** Join a summer focus group with a teacher leader. Below, please see the book options (with links) for possible opportunities for this summer. Up to 10 hours can be used for a guided focus group. This is for participation in the focus group. If books are needed, they will be acquired by the reader, not BC. *(Meetings taking place between June 13 - August 5, 2022 - unless noted otherwise.)*

<p><b>Visuals in the Classroom</b> <i>(Based on content from Structured TEACCH Training)</i></p>	<p><b>Dates: (choose one)</b> Option 1 - August 3 &amp; 4 @ GWAEA - 8:30AM - 3:30PM Option 2 - August 8 &amp; 9 @ BC - 8:30AM - 3:30PM <i>This course will provide the information and tools needed for basic support of students. The content of the class will include lectures covered during the 3 day Structured Teaching in the TEACCH Model class, as well as lectures on social stories, and communication strategies. There will be some in-class role-playing and assignments, question/answer sessions, and videotapes of students. Homework will be assigned to each participant during the first four classes.</i></p>
<p><b>Benchmark Advance - Guided Discovery</b></p>	<p><b>Dates: (choose one)</b> Option 1 - June 20th - 9:00-2:00 (dates depend on delivery of materials) Option 2 - June 27th - 9:00-2:00 (dates depend on delivery of materials) <i>Getting your hands on materials prior to the start of the school year is always a bonus for summer planning. We will be exploring all things Benchmark Advance in this "hands-on" learning option. <b>Effective Classroom Practices</b>	<p><b>Date:</b> June 13th - 8:30AM - 3:00PM</p> <p><i>Classroom Strategies for Preventing and Responding to Problem Behavior - This course is designed for all grade levels and classroom types.</i></p>
<b>Computer Science</b>	<p><b>Date:</b> TBD</p> <p><i>This session will provide time and opportunity for participants to learn more about computer science in Iowa. The focus will be on standards and instructional opportunities. This session will be helpful for those curious or just starting to learn about computer science and also those who have already knowledge of this topic.</i></p>
<b>Intervening at the Secondary Level</b>	<p><b>Date:</b> June 16th - 8:30 - 12:30</p> <p><i>We will spend time discussing MTSS and the role of interventions, specifically in the secondary system. The group will have time to look at intervention resources in the areas of academics, attendance, executive functioning, and SEBH.</i></p>

**Option 2: Collaborative Learning:** Learn and work with a team of your grade level or content alike partners during professional development break-out sessions with a teacher leader. Teachers may choose from the following options. ***(Meetings taking place between June 13 - August 5, 2022, unless otherwise noted.)***

- Deeper dive into planning for units of instruction based on priority standards (CL/DT Focus)
  - If this is the direction your team would like to pursue, you'll first need to submit an action plan for your time together. The action plan will guide the agenda and time together.
