



Data Collection Methods for Staff Goals

Method	Definition	When to use	Example Behaviors
Duration	Total time engaged in a behavior	To identify how long someone engages in a behavior	Amount of time spent supporting specified students in the gen ed setting, amount of time spent providing services as outlined in IEP
Latency	Amount of time that lapses between a directive and when the behavior begins	To identify how long before someone engages in a behavior	Time between clocking in and starting first duty of the day, time between transitions and starting next task
Percent	Number of correct responses	To identify the accuracy of a behavior	Accuracy of implementing strategies with fidelity, accuracy of completing a task as outlined on a job aide
Rate	Frequency of a behavior over a period of time	To identify how often a behavior occurs within a certain time frame	Frequency of student interactions during recess, frequency of verbal prompts provided during math small group
