Explained how she can make an appointment with her counselor, and get further assistance. Also informed them of the EL Program office in case they need additional support. This will be their first year in a US school.
3. Another parent wanted additional support for her daughter. This is the student's first year in a US school and the student wants additional support and help with the English Language. Parents requested the 2<sup>nd</sup> period tutoring. Informed them of the tutoring services available after school and encouraged the student to attend. I will also follow up and invite the student to 2<sup>nd</sup> period tutoring to help her transition to CUHS.
