Social-Emotional Learning and School Skills

Literacy

We have finished all the new concepts we are going to learn this year! We are working on becoming fluent and applying all that we have learned through review games and activities.

We read *Enemy Pie by Derek Munson*. The vocabulary words we discussed were enemy, recipe, squinted, and surprised. We also read *The Sandwich Swap*. We compared the texts and talked about the common theme of friendship.

Writing

The journal prompt Friday was how can we make an enemy a friend. We also planned and did our sunshine writing. We thought of reasons why the sun is our friend.




Mathematics

We continue to count to 110 this week! We also continue to count by 5s and 10s. This week week we talked about money! We discussed using money to buy things, We focus on the coins: penny, dime, nickel, and quarter. Students should be able to describe the physical

features of each quarter. They should also know that a penny is worth 1 cent, a dime is worth 10 cents, a nickel is worth 5 cents, and a quarter is worth 25 cents. They should know how many pennies equal each coin. Given certain mixed coins they should be able to count up the total amount of cents they have. To help us do this we talked about using the strategy touch points. A touch point is worth 5 cents. A dime has 2 touch points. A nickel has 1 touch point. A quarter has 5 touch points. A penny has no touch points, we just have to know that the penny is worth 1 cent. We also learned that this is the cents symbol ϕ .

Content

This week we continued to review plants. We will continue to talk about what we have learned about plants and the parts of a plant.

FOOD AND DRINK POLICY

We have snack everyday in the afternoon during writing. I ask that you only send water if possible to avoid any mess. We also only have a limited time, so I ask that it only be a small amount of food

LUCKY DUCK

Each day we will have someone be our lucky duck. For that day they will get to lead the line, share, deliver things, feed and water the hermit crabs, choose the seat they want, and anything else that might come up that day. The share is very important as it means that day that get to bring something in and tell the class about it. If they forget to bring something it is totally okay they can always choose something in our classroom to share. In the classroom we have ducks with a number on the bottom that represents each student. At the end of each month we will pull ducks to see who is the lucky duck each day next month. I will record who it is each day on a calendar and share that with you at the bottom of our newsletter. They will always get to be the lucky duck on their birthday.
