## Instructions for a Storyboard Form

The goal of a storyboard is to try to become as familiar as possible with the <u>term</u> by trying

- 1. Gain as many facts as possible for the <u>term</u> through a Who, What When, Where, and Why set of questions.
- 2. By thinking about why the <u>term</u> came to exist, OR how it might have affected something else.
- 3. By thinking about all of the people, places, and events that are associated with the term.
- 4. AFTER you have gathered enough information to understand the term completely, you are now to put together the facts and information in three parts, a beginning, a middle, and and end part. It may or may not be a term that is described by time. **This** is where you simplify the information into three parts.
- 5. AFTER you have simplified the information, you can now **draw pictures** for each part. You may or may not want to use colored pencils. For each picture, provide at least a **one word caption**.
