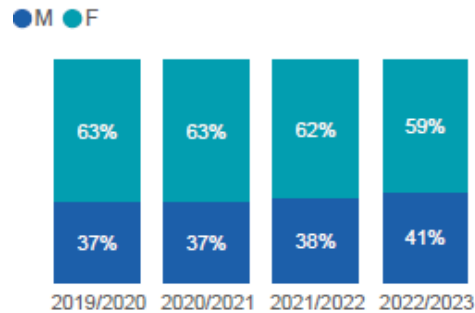




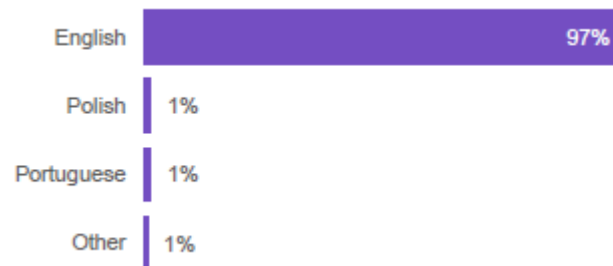

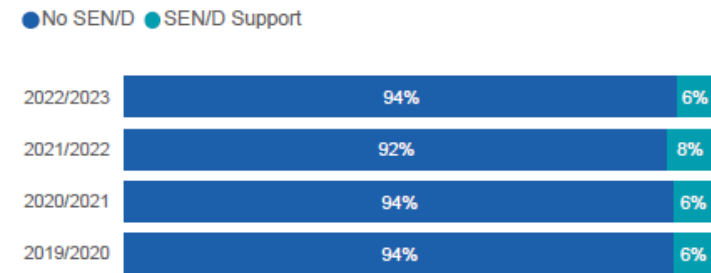
## % Gender – School

## Attainment Summary

Under the assessment framework (2014), the terms 'Emerging', 'Developing' and 'Secure' are used to show the extent to which a pupil has understood and can apply what they have been taught at the end of each academic year, for pupils from Year 1 to Year 6. For most pupils, the assessment judgements will correspond with the curriculum objectives for the chronological year group that they are in. For example, a pupil in Year 2 may be assessed as 2 Emerging, 2 Developing or 2 Secure. Pupils assessed against curriculum objectives below their chronological year group are likely to have identified Special Educational Needs (SEN), or other significant barrier(s) to learning.



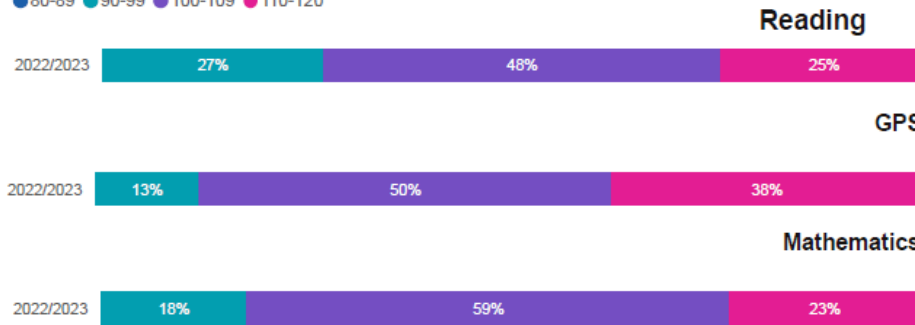

## **FCJ Primary School (% School) End of Key Stage Two SATs Attainment Data (Y6) Compared to All-Island Schools**

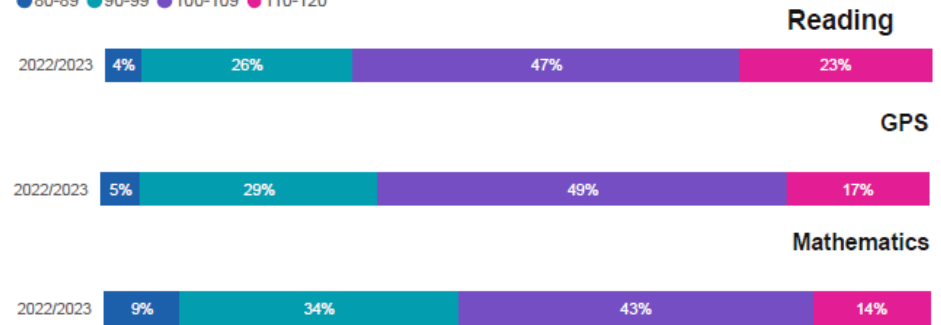

### ***Reading***

25% of pupils at FCJ scored between 110-120 in their SATs compared to 23% across all mainstream Government schools.

### ***GPS (Grammar Punctuation & Spelling)***

38% of pupils at FCJ scored between 110-120 in their SATs compared to 17% across all mainstream Government schools.

### ***Mathematics***

23% of pupils at FCJ scored between 110-120 in their SATs compared to 14% across all mainstream Government schools.

#### ***Reading***

98% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 90% across all mainstream Government schools.

75% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Secure or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 74% across all mainstream Government schools.

100% of children achieved their Minimum Expected Grade (MEG), with 14% exceeding their MEG (set from Y2 data).

#### ***Writing***

96% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 87% across all mainstream Government schools.

66% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Secure or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 60% across all mainstream Government schools.

100% of children achieved their Minimum Expected Grade (MEG), with 39% exceeding their MEG (set from Y2 data).

#### ***Mathematics***

91% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 87% across all mainstream Government schools.

68% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Secure or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 64% across all mainstream Government schools.

100% of children achieved their Minimum Expected Grade (MEG), with 29% exceeding their MEG (set from Y2 data).

#### ***Reading***

70% of pupils in Year 2, who joined FCJ in Reception, were assessed as Secure or above within their year group at the end of KS1. This compares to 66% across all mainstream Government schools.

100% of children achieved their Minimum Expected Grade (MEG), with 32% exceeding their MEG (set from YR data).

#### ***Writing***

65% of pupils in Year 2, who joined FCJ in Reception, were assessed as Secure or above within their year group at the end of KS1. This compares to 52% across all mainstream Government schools.

100% of children achieved their Minimum Expected Grade (MEG), with 32% exceeding their MEG (set from YR data).

#### ***Mathematics***

70% of pupils in Year 2, who joined FCJ in Reception, were assessed as Secure or above within their year group at the end of KS1. This compares to 61% across all mainstream Government schools.

100% of children achieved their Minimum Expected Grade (MEG), with 28% exceeding their MEG (set from YR data).

#### ***Reading***

75% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 59% across all mainstream Government schools.

#### ***Writing***

75% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 54% across all mainstream Government schools.

#### ***Mathematics***

50% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 58% across all mainstream Government schools.

### **Mathematics**

100% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS1. This compares to 59% across all mainstream Government schools.
