The mission of the Parent / Community Volunteer Program is to provide the best education possible for each student in our schools by involving parents and community members in meeting the varying and diverse needs of our students.

Parent / Community volunteer opportunities are available during school hours in grades 6-8. Volunteers assist students -- some who may be struggling, others who need to reinforce skills and still others who need enrichment -- in various ways and in many subjects. We try to match volunteer interests and talents with a variety of positions.

How to Become an MMS Volunteer

There are **Three** requirements that must be met every school year in order to be considered for volunteering at Miamisburg Middle Schools:

- 1. Fill out the Volunteer Google Form
- 2. Have a valid background screening approved by Miamisburg City Schools
- 3. Attend Volunteer Training / Orientation

Types of Volunteers:

Lunch / Recess Volunteer

Volunteers would provide an additional adult presence to engage and interact with students during lunch and recess. This volunteer experience may be outdoors or indoors depending on weather. Volunteers are needed 1-5 days a week from 10:45-1:00 p.m.

Classroom Volunteer

Volunteers assist teachers so they have additional resources to help meet each student's learning needs. Interactions may occur in a variety of circumstances (e.g. individual, small group, etc.). We endeavor to match the needs of the students and teachers with the volunteer's skills. Classroom opportunities vary depending on the needs of the teachers. *Volunteers are needed 1-5 days a week at various times of the school day 8:09-2:58 p.m.*
