A completely volunteer-run 501(c)3 organization, the Acrosstown provides a number of multicultural, socially relevant and alternative events. With dozens of events a year, something is always happening at the ART! Our mainstage shows range from topical drama to period pieces to comedy, and our aim is to start a conversation and create theatre for thinking people.

ABOUT US

The Acrosstown Repertory Theatre is a registered 501(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to producing quality live theatre in the Gainesville area. We have been providing progressive, quality theatre since 1980.

The ART produces 7+ productions each year, including at least one full-scale musical. In addition to our core production work, our group conducts educational and fun activities for our members and the community at large, including an annual playwrights festival that features local writing talent.

The ART also provides theatre space to other local or traveling performance groups including student theatre companies, musical groups, burlesque troupes, and more. A number of our members have gone on to work in theatre professionally, and the ART has continued to see its mission fulfilled as a hub for culture, cooperation, and the presentation of top quality theatre.

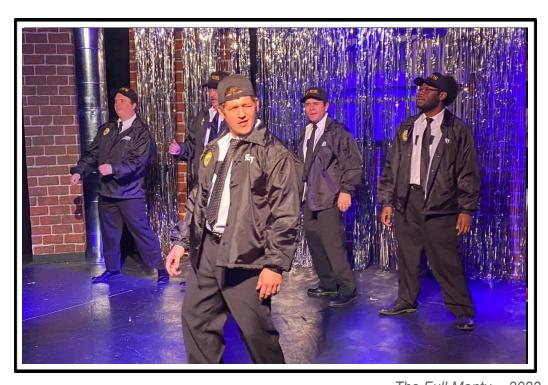

PRODUCTION SPONSOR \$500 +

Production Sponsorships defray operational expenses so that more resources can be allotted to production costs such as set, sound, costumes, and royalty fees. This is a huge value over the Performance Sponsorship level, for each production has typically 9-15 performances. For five hundred dollars or more, you can be highlighted for the entire run of a show.

At this level, you can pick a title from our season to sponsor. Love Shakespeare? Sponsor our Summer Shakespeare production. Interested in the avant-garde? We have something in our season for that too. Pick the show that best fits your aesthetic and become a sponsor!

Five Hundred Dollars can fund the production budget for an entire show (set, props, costumes, everything). It can also upgrade a piece of our lighting and sound equipment.

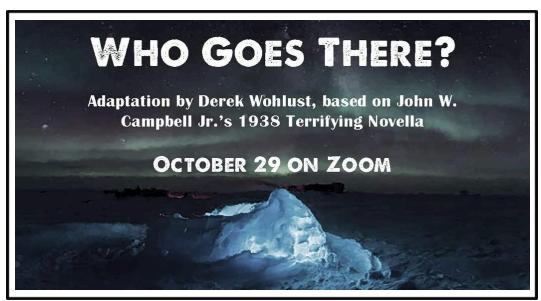
SEASON LEADING SPONSOR \$5,000 +
