# Families/users have the ability to check prior program registrations in their GotSport account.

- Check if you registered for Fall AND Spring already
- Check your registration answers e.g. uniform sizes, tryout attendance, etc.

You can follow the steps below to review your registrations.

Navigation within your GotSport profile is easiest on desktop (rather than mobile).

## Step 1

Login to your GotSport account at <a href="https://system.gotsport.com/">https://system.gotsport.com/</a>

You must be logged into the correct GotSport account to view a registration. For example if you are a coach and have your own GotSport account that is not tied to the rest of your family, you will not see your children's registration if your spouse registered them. If you have separate accounts contact <a href="mailto:admin@needhamsoccer.com">admin@needhamsoccer.com</a> to have them connected.


## Step 2

When logged in select "Program Registrations" in the top menu bar.



# Step 3

You'll see a list of all your previous program registrations on GotSport. Find your Fall 2023 - Spring 24 Player registration and click "View". If you have multiple children on your account you can click into them separately.




## Step 4

On the "Info" tab, you can view the Payment Plan you selected with your Fall registration. The example below is a "Fall AND Spring" registration.

If you registered only for Fall, it will say "Fall Only", and you will need to register again for Spring if you wish to participate.

In the case of Fall/Spring registrations - it is the <u>PAYMENT PLAN</u> name that will show which seasons you registered for.



## Step 5

To check on some of the specifics in your registration (e.g. your friend request, uniform sizes or travel tryouts attendance), you can click the "Registration" tab.(Please Note, while there is the ability to edit your selections in your registration, any changes made after the registration deadline will not be count).

## **Team Formation**

Teams in our non-Travel programs - Grades 1-6, as well as 7th/8th Grade Balanced Teams are formed by Program Directors based on the below criteria, in order of priority.

- arms in our non-travel programs Grades 1-6, as well as involved Grades beamcost teams are termed by Program Directors based on the bettor criteria, in order of priority.

  Children of head and assistant coaches will always be placed on the same team as their parent coach. One friend request for Head (only) coach's children will be honored where practical.

  Player evaluations where available, with the aim of creating teams as relatively equal in skill/experience level as possible. This does not apply to first grade fall season.

  A balance of schools attended on each team to encourage players to meet new children and avoid teams dominated by any one school

  A balance between school grades in dwal age groups (not applicable to burier Academy) and oraclemy and orapity equal relative to the age group.

  Teams will be mixed up from spring to fall and will not stay together from one year to the next. Teams will typically stay similar between Fall and Spring, but may be broken up when necessary due to coach and player registration, or an identified imbalance. We are not able to make changes between Fall and Spring by request.

  After the above criteria is used to create teams, we will apply QME FRIEND request (not a coach request) overlay and do our best to pair players up with a friend. It is not feasible to honor all friend request.
