Ops Groups Rotation

Outline process for becoming an OGR (as per Co-op handbook):

- Notice of OGR vacancies are sent to the staff, coordinators, members and volunteers of the relevant areas of the Project.
- Any employee, member or volunteer can put themselves forward for the role as long as they have the name of 1 other employee, member or volunteer willing to nominate them.
 If more than 1 person applies, the employees, members or volunteers from the relevant area of the Project will be asked to vote.
- Every 6 months at the June and December Ops Group meeting, a minimum of one third
 of OGRs those who are longest standing will stand down, although they will be eligible
 for re-election.

Actions needed:

- Identify at least one third of OGRS (longest standing) willing to step down: Krysia, Tim, Julien, Seonaid (Krysia & Tim willing to continue if no other reps come forward).
- Notice of vacancies to go out to Members on Thursday 16 May
- Those who are nominated to come to June OGM


Member lows of 2018 included: uncertainty over premises, EAB stock management, communication between community programmes, parking, Kat leaving:(




OGRs should bear all of this in mind when bringing forward proposals / prioritising work etc


