Subsequently, provide a review of at least five related studies conducted within the last five years, emphasizing their relevance to your research. This review should highlight the GAP analysis of your study compared to the existing literature. Conclude the introduction by outlining the objectives of your research and the outcomes you aim to achieve.

It is recommended that authors use the following article structure: **INTRODUCTION – METHOD – RESULTS AND DISCUSSION – CONCLUSION**. The article should not exceed 8-12 pages.




Figure 1. Stages of the Waterfall Method
