The Big Point: God Always Keeps His Promises God's Word: Noah and the Ark (Genesis 6-9:17)


Memory Verse: God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who

Introduce NEW kids to everyone! Share with one another what their favourite colour is. Just like rainbow, there are 7 colours, what color do they like the most? Why?






Watch a video together (some of them may watch it if they were in church) Noah & the Flood therefore RAINBOW always reminds God's promises in our life.

In conclusion, God blessed Noah and his sons and promised them that he would never send another flood. And we know that God Always Keeps His Promises!


- God even gave them the rainbow in the sky as a sign of this promise to Noah his family and all of mankind. God Always Keeps His Promises!



Activity 5 - Ark Making



Materials:

- 1. Ice cream sticks
- 2. Glue
- 3. Marker

Steps:

- Lay out sticks on piece of paper (building/ creating an ark)
- 2. Glue the sticks on the paper
- 3. Use a marker to outline the Ark you had created.
- 4. You can draw animals, rainbow & Noah (with his family) in the ark as well
- 5. Write BIG POINT on the paper: **God Always Keeps His Promises**

Instructions to make your Families for Life Share-the-Care Red Ribbon Badge



 You will need 4 strips of 2cm-width red ribbons at 30cm each, scissors, stapler, sticky tape, double-sided tape or glue and a marker or pen.



 Combine the 2 sets of ribbons from Step 3 and staple them as shown.



 Write your thank you note on the 8cm circle



 Use sticky tape to link the 4 strips of red ribbon together to make 4 loops.



5) Cut 2 circles (8cm and 9cm each).



 Paste a double-sided tape or glue the back of the thank you note and paste it on top of the 9cm circle.



Combine 2 loops of red ribbons and staple in the middle. Make 2 sets.



 Place the 9cm circle on top of the red ribbons and staple.



 Clip a lanyard or tie a string to the top ribbon loop and present this badge to someone to show that you care.
