Obtaining an instrument

A central factor in achieving success on an instrument is the quality of the instrument. Please peruse the rental information linked below for both Johnstonbaugh's and Volkweins, and make the best choice for your family. For a child to have success on a musical instrument, it is critical that the instrument be of good quality, fitted correctly, and be in good playing condition. Children are rarely successful when they play on instruments that are of the wrong size, poor quality, or in poor working condition and sadly many of the "great deals" advertised online are most often poor quality instruments. If you have an heirloom instrument we suggest you contact the instrumental staff and ask them to evaluate the condition. Purchasing instruments from the internet or non professional outlets is risky and frequently results in costly repairs to bring it up to standards. If you have any questions on any of these materials, please contact the instrumental music teacher at your child's school. Should your financial circumstances make it difficult to obtain an instrument, please know that a limited number of school-owned instruments are available for little or no fee for your child to use. Please contact us for more information.
