## **Student Workload Survey Results**

## A. Lecture

- 1. As many as 81.2% of students think that a load of lecture assignments is not burdensome for students
- 2. As many as 73.6% of students think that the number of assignments in the course ranges between few and enough
- 3. As many as 98.9% of students think that the assignments given are relevant to the lectures
- 4. As many as 97.1% of students think that the assignments are given improve the understanding of lectures
- 5. The forms of preferred and valuable assignments for students are 42.8% presentation assignments, 40.8% journal reviews, 13.7% papers making, and 2.7% videos making.
- 6. The most overburdened tasks for students are 54.1% video making, 25.7% papers making, 10.8% presentations, and 9.4% reviews.
- 7. As many as 53.3% of students think that group assignments are preferable.

Conclusion: Lectures and lecture assignments do not burden the students. Assignments that the students prefer are presentations and journal reviews both in groups and individually

## **B. Practicum**

- 1. 100% of students consider the practical material relevant to the lecture material
- 2. As many as 99.3% of students think that the practical material improves the understanding of the lecture materials
- 3. A total of 58.9% of students think that the practicum load is moderate, and 33.5% think that the practicum load is heavy
- 4. As many as 98.7% of students think that the practicum guide provided is good quality
- 5. A total of 98.7% of students think that the laboratory facilities are good
- 6. As many as 98% of students think that the quality of laboratory assistants guiding the practicums is good to excellent
- 7. A total of 99% of students think that the implementation of the practicum is quite good to very good

Conclusion: The implementation and practicum facilities are good, and the practicum materials are relevant to the lectures, but 33% of students think that the practicum is heavy
