Monogram Stenciled Canvas Bag

Supplies:

Canvas tote bag (I chose white, but you could use the natural as well)

Soft Fabric Paint (I used black, but again, you could use any color)

Large Paper Doily (I used the 12" size)

Adhesive Spray

sponge brush for paint (not pictured)

Directions:

- Spray one side of doily with spray adhesive (trust me, you don't want to skip this step) then place doily on one corner of bag
- Use fabric paint to paint over holes in doily
- Carefully remove doily before paint dries
- Monogram

For the monogram I used freezer paper and with an A- Xacto knife I cut out the letter. Then lay the paper on the bag wax side down and iron to the back just enough for it to stick. Then paint over the letter and peel off freezer paper.

Once everything is dry iron to set paint.

Blocks

Supplies:

- Blocks
- Paper
- Mod podge
- Paint brush
- Letters (stickers, wooden, or printed on paper)

You can buy the blocks online or in the unfinished would section at any craft store.

Directions:

Cut squares slightly smaller then the blocks and mod podge them on using a paint brush. Make sure you do the bottom and the top of the paper. If making blocks as a child's toy use no toxic mod podge.

Magic Sleigh Bell Supplies:

Glass jar Jingle bell Christmas stems Ribbon Christmas paper Stickers

Stuff the jar making sure the bell is visible. Add stickers to the front and a note that says:

"Santa's Special bell from his sleigh given only to children who have been good."



Supplies:

Yarn or twine Hot glue Craft wrath Embellishment

Directions:

Wrap wreath with material hot gluing as you go. Make sure to keep it really tight. Hot glue your embellishment and enjoy!
