

## Privacy Policy for Policy Scanner

Effective date: April 12, 2026

Policy Scanner is a Chrome extension that helps users detect and summarize Terms of Service, Privacy Policies, Cookie Policies, and similar legal content on webpages.

This Privacy Policy explains what information the extension processes, how it is used, and how it is handled.

### 1. What the extension does

Policy Scanner scans webpages for legal-policy content such as Terms of Service, Privacy Policies, Cookie Policies, and related legal notices. When relevant content is found, the extension may generate summaries and display them in the extension popup or directly on the page.

### 2. Information processed

The extension may process:

Text content from webpage sections or links that appear to contain legal-policy information

The URL of the page being analyzed

Temporary extension state needed to associate detected content with the active browser tab

The extension is designed to focus on policy-related content only.

### 3. How information is used

The processed information is used only to:

Detect legal-policy content on webpages

Generate summaries of that content

Show those summaries to the user inside the extension interface

### 4. Remote processing

To generate summaries, policy-related text may be sent to a backend service operated for Policy Scanner:

That backend may use third-party AI processing services to generate summaries.

### 5. Data storage

Policy Scanner does not intend to permanently store users' personal browsing data. Temporary cached data may be kept briefly in extension memory or browser extension storage only as needed to make popup and inline summary features work correctly.

### 6. Data sharing

Policy Scanner does not sell user data.

Policy-related text may be shared only with:

The Policy Scanner backend service

Third-party AI or infrastructure providers strictly as needed to generate summaries and operate the service

#### 7. User control

Users control when they install, enable, use, disable, or remove the extension. Users can also stop use of the extension at any time by disabling or uninstalling it from Chrome.

#### 8. Security

Reasonable efforts are made to protect transmitted and processed data. However, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and absolute security cannot be guaranteed.

#### 9. Children's privacy

Policy Scanner is not intended for children under 13, and it is not knowingly designed to collect personal information from children.

#### 10. Changes to this Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time. Any updates will be reflected by posting the revised version at the same public URL.
