

Shredder: Climate Impact

We made huge efforts to keep the project as sustainable as we could, especially considering the act of destruction. This included second-hand costumes, repurposed set pieces and primarily using paper already destined for the shredder.

Costume

The primary look for the show was bought second-hand. It is a former boilersuit for a mechanic. All costumes in the film are sourced from participants and/or charity shops.

Set

The set is light, with a trolley and two tables borrowed from Dublin Fringe.

The shredder was purchased (for €10!) at Habitat for Humanity, Drogheda (highly recommend this charity shop, including a huge DIY section)

Paper usage

Approx 85% of the paper was scrap paper or things already destined for shredding.
