

## Discussion Forum Activity

# Enheduanna and her poetry hymns:

Let us engage with one another and share how early poetry delights, educates us, about facing challenges and obstacles in her live time in Discussion 2.

**GOALS:** **1)** Build 'critical reading' skills of hymns & verse, **2)** Identify *how* the hymns by Enheduanna 'delight' us – meaning 'educate' us – on she responds to instability and conflict.

- a) For example, how do her poetic lines reflect ideas on facing obstacles
- b) How do they inform us about ways to face such challenges in our own times?

**DIRECTIONS:** Follow steps to share your insights/thoughts on a chosen writer's delight & authority:

- a) Choose a hymn by Enheduanna
- b) Address how its lines inform us about her lived experiences
- c) Then, chose a quote to post in the discussion forum to explain what you learn
- d) Add any reflections on how her faced challenges remind you one of our own times; do any of the challenges faced reflect topics pertaining to sustainability. Which ones? How so?
- e) End your posting by asking a question to your peers about how Enheduanna's hymn assists us in learn about our own times and experiences.
