- Spring sports are in full swing. Culminating events will start taking place before the next booster meeting, so here is information on those:

 - Soccer- Regionals at Cheyenne 5/9-5/11, State at Rock Springs 5/16-5/18
 - Softball- No Conference, State at Gillette 5/16-5/18
- Tennis windscreens: I sent the booster club email a quote for new tennis windscreens that would include design/camel logo on the outside of the windscreen. The windscreen quote/model I sent would be a year round windscreen. Please let me know what your thoughts are on this.
