An email was sent out from Juliana Scricco earlier this week about the end-of-the-year senior information. Seniors will need to sign and return the [Senior Graduation Contract](#) to their counselor before graduation. They will also need to complete the [Senior Graduation Survey](#). Counselors will be presenting this in health and PE classes on May 20 and 21.

Students will also need to log into Scoir and update their decisions (accepted, denied, waitlisted, deferred, etc) and set the school they will be attending in the fall. If this is not done, then the final transcript will not be sent. If you are not going to attend college, you can still let us know whether you are going into the workforce, entering the military, or taking time off.
