

Bradley Girls Lacrosse Rules Player/ Parent Agreement

*By February 20th each player and parent must sign this paper to participate in the Bradley Girls Lacrosse Team. If this agreement is not signed and returned your daughter will not be able to participate. The player also needs to be compliant to try out for lacrosse (Register on final forms, player and parent signature on final forms, physical, passing 5 classes, and pay to play).

Player Expectations

1. Varsity requirements: 8 minute mile, complete wall ball test in 3:30/3:45 or under, and attendance of both practices and games.
2. Be a leader both in and out of the classroom, and on and off the field.
3. Come to practices, games, meetings, etc, prepared, on time (15 minutes before the start), and with a positive attitude.
4. High academic standards will be expected (attend all classes, be on time to all classes, and pass all classes)

Practice and Game Rules

1. Athletes may be excused from practice only by Coach Meads' permission. All practices and games are a requirement, missing/ late to either will affect playing time.
2. If a player misses the practice before a game, play time will be affected for that game.
3. If a player misses 2 practices a week, she will not compete in the next game.
4. Continuous unexcused absences will terminate the players participation on the team.
5. Profane language, fighting, bullying, or bad attitudes will not be tolerated and will result in negative consequences including affecting playing time, or removal from the team.
6. No jewelry is to be worn during lacrosse season (starts first day of tryouts).
7. You must wear proper lacrosse equipment to practice (penny, mouth guard, stick, goggles) and Bradley Lacrosse colors to practice (Black, gray/silver, blue, white)
8. Varsity line up will be determined by Coach Meads and Coach Tave. Players have the ability to consistently gain or lose playing time, and defined roles.
9. Playing time should only be addressed from player to coach. This should also take place 24 hours after the game took place.
10. No cellphones out at practice or games.
11. No conversations outside of lacrosse at practice or games (especially sidelines).
12. Players should be picked up promptly after events are over.

Traveling

1. We all travel to, during, and from games as a team. Coach Meads needs written permission, at least 1 day ahead of time, to excuse a player from riding the bus.
2. Maintain a professional appearance, at games and tournaments players must wear Bradley Apparel Only.
3. During Games the team must sit together.
4. Players must always be a good sport and be a good representative of Bradley High School. Be mindful of what you say in the stands, at school, and around the community!!
