

## Call for Intramural Grant Proposals from Research Interest Groups

The College of Veterinary Medicine, Office for Research is now accepting up one proposal from each of our three Research Interest Groups.

The goal of these grants is to **support Research Interest Groups in fostering scholarship of their members, preferably through initiatives that will benefit most members.**

**Up to \$10,000 may be requested for use within 12 months of award and submission of a final report detailing outcomes within 6 months after the end of the project.** Use of matching funds from other sources is encouraged. If so, include how these will be used in the budget. Proposals must be endorsed by a RIG and only one proposal can be submitted per group.

**Application:** All proposals should not exceed 5 pages of **single spaced, 11pt Arial font, with 1" margins** and follow the following outline:

- Title
- Respective roles / responsibilities of members (Minimum one leader, responsibility for timely progress, any advertising, recruiting, reports and budget management etc...)
- Summary ½ page
- Background and rationale for the proposal
- Objectives – purpose
- Plan
- Timeline
- Expected outcomes
- References (do not count in the page limit)
- **Budget and justification** (d not count in the page limit)

Proposals should be submitted in Word .docx format to [CVMResearch@westernu.edu](mailto:CVMResearch@westernu.edu) .

Proposals will be reviewed by the RAC based on each aspect of the application, with an emphasis on the likelihood of impact (such as future extramural funding, original research peer-reviewed publications, feasibility).

**Proposals will be reviewed on an ongoing basis but must be received by December 1, 2022.**

Award decisions will be made on an ongoing basis and by December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Funds will be disbursed within two weeks of acceptance.
