Good afternoon AMS Families!

We have implemented an automated answering system in our main office to help better direct incoming phone calls. This should prevent so many calls needing to go to voicemail during our busiest times of the day.

We are happy to announce that we will be having our first Local Seafood day at Auburn Middle School this next Friday, 11/12, with locally caught haddock as the main lunch choice. We've partnered with the Gulf of Maine Research Institute to increase the amount of local fresh fish in our menus for this upcoming school year. By serving seafood in our schools, not only are students benefiting from eating a healthy, lean, local protein, but we are helping to support our local seafood economy, from the fishermen to the dockside business to the seafood processors and distributors. Supporting local seafood has rippling economic impacts throughout the supply chain. The haddock will be breaded, baked, and served with a lemon parsley aioli paired with coleslaw, roasted new potatoes and apple crisp all prepared using locally sourced products as well.
