Deciding what events you want to go to and which people you definitely want to talk to is the most important concrete thing you can do to prepare. Therefore, if you're time-constrained: Join the preparation event. We might end up doing another one before November 1st if the Swapcard gets published a lot earlier.

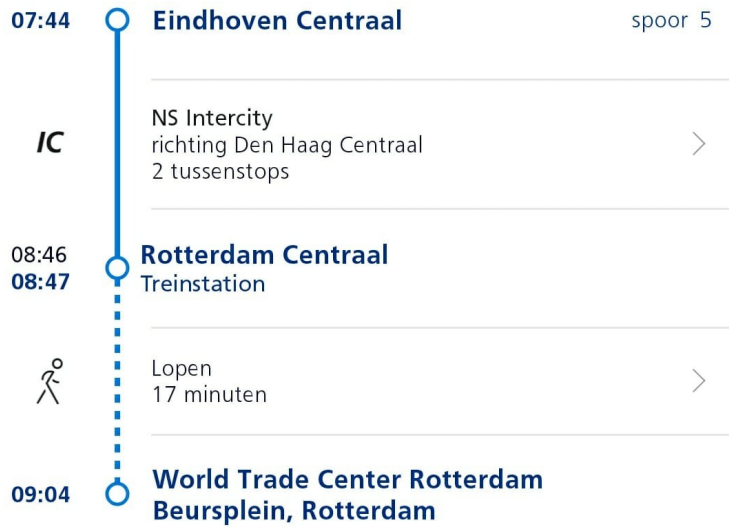
## Schedule

The precise schedule will be published on Swapcard, which is planned to launch on 24 October. You'll receive an email with instructions on how to install the app from the event organizers.

However, the schedule should look roughly like this. As for the importance of attending which days, it's about 15%-40%-45% for Fri-Sat-Sun):

- Friday 16:00 - 19:00: Kick-off, social stuff, introduction talks, meetups
- Saturday 9:00 - 19:00 Main content (Several simultaneous talks, workshops, meetups, and hundreds of people to schedule meetings with at any given, so many decisions to be made)
- Saturday 19:00 - 23:59 social
- Sunday 9:00 - 19:00: Main content (Same as Saturday)
- Sunday 19:00 - Monday morning: Various afterparties, including chill ones where you can just talk to people. I'm not much of a party person myself but highly recommend staying on Sunday for this!

## Travel and accommodation



Since this conference is nearby, it will depend per person whether it makes sense to stay at a hostel/hotel or travel from Eindhoven. However, your time is valuable at the conferences, and unless you have a weekend public transport subscription it might even be straight-up cheaper to book a hostel in Rotterdam (Hostel is ~30 euros per night, the train is ~20 euros, and almost 1.5 hours one way).

We can coordinate and book a hostel together, so if you also want to stay in Rotterdam, react with 👍 to this message. If you want to stay for different days than Fri-Mon, let me know. (Am considering only booking Fri-Sat myself and just staying up Sunday night).

For the coordination around hotels for all attendees of the event (including couch-sharing, hotel discount codes, useful group chats, and unaffiliated events happening the same weekend, check out [accommodation guide]).

One final note: Food (all vegan) is provided at the venue, including breakfast. That should be all for now. Good luck with your preparation, am excited for November! :)
