


Canvas Website and App for Parents of Students in 5-12

Why Canvas?: One stop shop for assignments, announcements, and grades

What is Canvas?: Learning Management System used nationally for grades k-higher education. Canvas is a digital classroom to support student learning whether at home or school.

How do I Use it?: Canvas has two ways to support parents: through the app or through the website (alder.instructure.com). Parents are called "observers" in Canvas. Here are step by step instructions to get you started.

To "pair with observer", the student will go to alder.instructure.com and open "Settings" and select "Pair with Observer", then copy the code for the parent.



Then, the parent or guardian will open Canvas URL in a browser


https://alder.instructure.com/login/canvas OR go directly to the app store to download the Canvas PARENT app (blue icon).

For Parent App:

- 1) When prompted to find school, select Jonathan Alder PARENT
- 2) Follow prompts using student pairing code as instructed above.
- 3) Click on upper right hand corner menu and select "manage children" and click on plus sign in upper right hand corner to add additional students
- 4) Also under "manage children" you can set individual parent notifications by clicking on the child's name

For Parent Access on Computer or Internet Browser Click "Need a Canvas

Account?" and then "Parents Sign up Free" followed by sign up details using PARENT'S INFORMATION (do not use school provided student or staff email).





Begin Observing To add more students, go to

parent "account", and "observing". You will need an observer code for each child.
