- I feel that there should be a Review Process for all caches prior to being forcibly archived involving a corps of 'qualified' Geocachers in this manner. First, qualified Geocachers: having over 2,000 finds with at least 20 hides with a good history of finds, Favorite Points, knowledge of Guidelines and quality of hide both placed and maintained (from logs and Reviewer interaction). No competition just a RANDOM drawing from qualified candidates willing to serve for a year to cover a Geographic area. This would ensure that knowledgeable 'cachers are accomplishing the Process.

The Process: prior to being forcibly archived, a period of 30 days' 'Inspection'
time be allowed for the qualified 'cachers in that region to Physically inspect the
cache and give a report regarding the cache. The adoptable caches would then
be placed on an Adoption webpage for the region - adoptable by any Premium
member with a good record of maintenance on their hides. This would all be

advertised by HQ - and also a message carried by all Lackeys to Events and by Reviewers as well. This would ensure that "important", deserving or Historic caches would have a second chance at life - and also that poor caches get archived.

 The only hold-up in the past has been 'legal issues', but these seem to have been sidestepped in at least some instances.

 The recent "inspection" of some number of 'caches by HQ appointed 'cachers actually is along the lines of this process which I have been touting for several years.

Archiving a geocache is meant to be a permanent action. Only community volunteer reviewers and Geocaching HQ can unarchive caches. This is done only in rare circumstances and only if the cache meets the current geocaching guidelines.

If a cache is archived by a reviewer or staff for lack of maintenance, it will not be unarchived
