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A Resolution Addressing the Need for Can Openers at the Food Resource Center

WHEREAS, The mission of the Hamline Undergraduate Student Congress (HUSC) is to address students' needs; and,

WHEREAS, the Food Resource Center is highly utilized by Hamline University community members; and,

WHEREAS, the lack of can openers available to students has created a barrier to food security and accessibility; and,

WHEREAS, the Food Resource Center is currently funded in part by the Hamline Undergraduate Student Congress (HUSC); and,

WHEREAS, the current budget for the Food Resource Center did not account for the can opener need; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of purchasing 100 can openers and having them available for students to check out from the Food Resource Center is \$939; and,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Food Resource Center will manage the purchasing and distribution of the can openers upon the passing of this resolution; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that \$939 of the Capital Improvement Budget be allocated to the purchase of can openers for the Food Resource Center.
