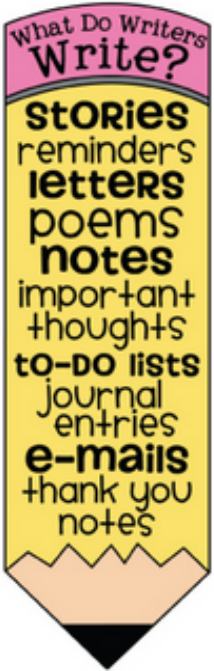

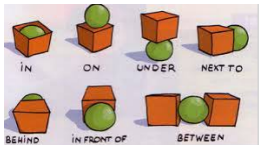
Writing



Writing is integrated with the Skills Strand in Language Arts. Throughout the year, students learn the decoding skills needed for (future) independent reading. Each Skills lesson begins with a warm-up, review of previously taught content in reading, writing, and/or grammar.

Unit Seven Writing Skills

- One and Two-Syllable Word with
 - 'ai and 'ay > /ae/
 - 'oa' > /oe/
 - 'ai', 'ay' > /ae/
- Two Syllable Words with -ed or -ing endings
- Response to text sentences (with citation) and paragraph
- Friendly Letter

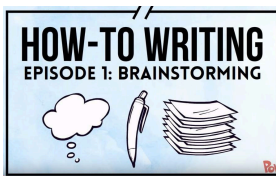
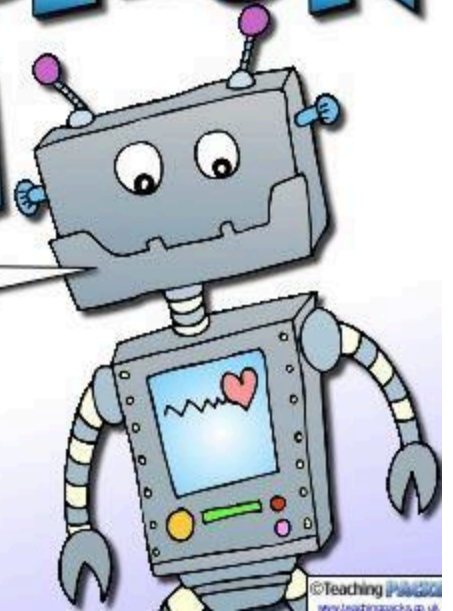
Students are Introduced to Instructional *How-To) Writing
