### **POLICY 4526.E**

#### **STUDENT USE OVERVIEW & AGREEMENTS**

The Southold Union Free School District appreciates the educational value of providing students and staff access to the District's Computer Network, including access to the Internet. Positive educational use of these resources has resulted in powerful learning experiences. The District considers access to these resources to be an important educational research tool for students and staff in the 21st Century. However, access to the District's Computer Network and Internet is a privilege, not a right. As such, certain responsibilities fall upon the user to ensure proper use of these resources.

1. The individual in whose name an account or a device is issued is responsible at all times for its proper use.
2. Any Computer Network user who is identified as a security risk, or as having a history of violations of District computer use guidelines, may be denied access to the Computer Network.
3. Computer Network users have no expectation of privacy with respect to any data stored or transmitted via the District's Computer Network, or used in conjunction with the Computer Network. School officials shall monitor the use of the District's Computer Network and can and will search, at any time, the account, e-mail, disks, files, or other data stored on the District's Computer Network.

#### Internet and Electronic Device Usage

1. Registered personal electronic devices (e.g. iPads, Chromebooks, notebook computers, cell phones), district owned devices, and peripherals (e.g. headphones, speakers) may be used on school grounds as long as such use does not cause a disturbance or hazard.
2. The district is not responsible for securing personally-owned devices & peripherals nor their repair, upkeep, or replacement. The District is not responsible for securing District owned devices and peripherals that have been assigned to individuals.
3. All devices that access the Internet must be registered with the District.
4. All access to the Internet or any outside servers must go through the District servers. No outside Internet providers may be accessed (e.g. 3G, 4G, satellite, or cable provider wifi networks).
5. An administrator or teacher has the absolute right to ask a student to put such devices away at any time.
6. In hallways or common areas, any staff member has the absolute right to ask a student to put such devices away at any time.
7. Devices are not to be used in areas where privacy is expected (e.g. bathrooms, locker rooms).
8. Audio and visual recording devices are permitted with the following restrictions:

- A. No visual or audio recording should be made without the consent of the individuals being recorded.
- B. If in the classroom, permission from the teacher must be given prior to making the recording.

All users of the District's Computer Network and Internet must comply with the following policies:

- #4526- Computer Resources & Internet Access
- #4526-R- Computer Use In Instruction Regulation
- #4526.1- Internet Safety
- #4526.1-R- Internet Safety Regulation

Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action, as well as the suspension, restriction, and/or revocation of access privileges.
