

2025 – 2026 Toth Elementary School Supply Lists

As school supplies are very expensive, please feel free to “RECYCLE” any usable supplies that your child may already have at home.

There are three items we ask students in every grade to have:

- A change of clothes to keep in their locker
- An oversized paint shirt (labeled with the student’s name)
- A book bag (without wheels)

Kindergarten Supply List

- 1 soft sided lunch box with handles for supplies – unzips on three sides
- 12 yellow Ticonderoga pencils
- 3 boxes Crayola crayons – 24 count
- 2 boxes Crayola Classic markers – 10 pack
- 1 box colored pencils – 24 count
- 1 pair Fiskar scissors for kids
- 2 pink beveled erasers
- 12 glue sticks
- 1 bottle of Elmer’s school glue – 4 oz.
- 4 chisel dry erase markers
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags
- 1 box sandwich size Ziploc bags
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 oversized t-shirt for art
- 1 pair wired on-ear headphones
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 full set of change of clothes (socks, underwear, shorts, pants, & shirt)

First Grade Supply List

- 12 glue sticks
- 4 packs of crayons – 24 count
- 5 packs of Expo markers – 4 count, black
- 1 pair of child scissors
- 2 boxes of #2 sharpened pencils – 12 pack each
- 2 boxes of thick markers
- 8 highlighters
- 3 spiral notebooks
- 1 red plastic folder
- 1 blue plastic folder
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 set over the ear headphones
- GIRLS: 1 roll paper towels & 1 box gallon size bags
- BOYS: 1 container Clorox wipes & 1 box quart size bags

Second Grade Supply List

- 2 boxes crayons – 24 count
- 2 packs colored pencils – 12 count
- 12 glue sticks
- 1 pack broad Expo dry erase markers – 4 count
- 1 pack thin Expo dry erase markers – 4 count
- 1 – 1 in. view 3 ring binder (must have clear pocket on front)
- 2 boxes broad line markers – 10 count each
- 48 sharpened #2 pencils
- 1 – 4 oz. liquid school glue
- 1 pack of pencil cap erasers – 25 pack
- 3 – 2 pocket laminated folders (no prongs)
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 pack chunk erasers
- 1 pair pointed child scissors
- 9.5 cup rectangular plastic container for supplies (Glad/Ziploc)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 set corded headphones (NOT Bluetooth or earbuds)
- BOYS: 1 box sandwich sized Ziploc bags & 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- GIRLS: 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags & 1 pack of 2 highlighters

Third Grade Supply List

- 4 pack sharpened Ticonderoga pencils – 12 count
- 1 box of colored pencils – 24 count
- 1 box of crayons – 24 count
- 1 package of thick black Expo low order dry erase markers – 2 count
- 1 pair of children's pointed tip scissors
- 4 highlighters, different colors
- 1 single subject wide-ruled *royal blue* spiral notebook
- 1 pink pearl eraser or package of eraser pencil toppers
- 1 box fine line markers – 10 count
- 1 box of classic markers – 10 count
- 2 personal pencil sharpeners, no electric sharpeners
- 1 pack of glue sticks – 4 count
- 1 LARGE supply box for storing supplies (about 11.5 x 7.6 in.)
- 2-3 containers bleach-free disinfectant wipes
- 1 roll paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- GIRLS: 1 box quart sized Ziploc bags
- BOYS: 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags
- 1 centimeter/inch standard ruler (non bendy)
- 2-½ in. 3 ring binders
- 1 pair headphones or earbuds (non charging)
- 3 pack of Post-It notes
- 1 dry erase eraser or a sock (all teachers except Mrs. Campbell)

Fourth Grade Supply List

- 36 Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- 2 red pens
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 wide-ruled composition notebook (not spiral)
- 5 plastic two-pocket folders: 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 purple, 1 black
- 1 in. durable black clear view binder with pockets
- 8 black dry erase markers
- 4 highlighters: 2 yellow, 2 orange or pink
- 1 box of crayons – 24 count
- 6 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 - 8 pack markers (broad or fine point)
- 1 package of 3x3 sticky notes
- 2 zippered pencil pouches
- 1 set of earbuds or headphones
- 3 large boxes of tissues
- Last name A – M: 1 container of bleach free disinfectant wipes
- Last name N – Z: 1 roll of paper towels
