General Objectives	The IXP Office fosters global awareness and intercultural competence among students and Lasallian Partners by creating and supporting diverse opportunities for international exchange, collaboration, and engagement. Through strategic partnerships, innovative programs, and comprehensive support services, the office aims to enhance the educational experience, promote mutual understanding, and prepare the DLSZ community to thrive in an interconnected world.
Specific Objectives (Grade School)	1. Introduce basic cultural awareness and global citizenship concepts through interactive activities and age-appropriate content. 2. Facilitate virtual exchange programs with international partner schools to expose students to diverse cultures and perspectives. 3. Organize cultural fairs and language days to celebrate global diversity within the school community. 4. Incorporate global themes and international content into the curriculum to build foundational knowledge of different countries and cultures.
Specific Objectives (Junior High School)	1. Provide opportunities for short-term exchange programs and study tours to give students first-hand experience of different cultures and educational systems. 2. Develop language acquisition programs to enhance students’ proficiency in foreign languages. 3. Integrate global issues and international perspectives into the curriculum to deepen students’ understanding of global interconnectedness. 4. Encourage participation in international competitions, conferences, and collaborative projects to develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills in a global context.
Specific Objectives (Senior High School)	1. Offer long-term exchange programs and internships abroad to prepare students for global higher education and career opportunities. 2. Establish partnerships with international schools and universities for joint academic programs and research projects. 3. Organize workshops, seminars, and guest lectures by international experts to broaden students’ horizons and inspire global engagement. 4. Promote community service and volunteer opportunities with international organizations to instill a sense of global responsibility and empathy.
Specific Objectives (BRafeNHS)	1. Create tailored exchange programs and international experiences that accommodate the unique schedules and needs of night high school students. 2. Develop career-oriented international programs, such as apprenticeships and vocational training, to enhance employability in a global market. 3. Facilitate access to online international courses and certifications to provide flexible learning opportunities for students. 4. Foster a supportive environment for cultural exchange and language learning through cultural clubs and events.
