Attendance Dues for 2021 are due NOW

Attendance Dues are the compulsory property and insurance fee which parents and caregivers legally commit to pay when they enrol their child(ren) in a Catholic school. The dues are used to pay for the costs of new school classrooms, gymnasiums, technology blocks and other buildings, pay off existing mortgages and pay for the insurance on all school property.

When do I pay my 2021 attendance dues? Payment in full is due by **30 April 2021.** If you are <u>unable to pay the full amount</u> by 30 April 2021, you can make an arrangement to pay over the year in regular instalments. These arrangements must be agreed by the **Archdiocese Dues team**. You can pay your attendance dues <u>online at this link</u>.
