Late Work Policy

Homework:

Late homework (math, reading "log" in planner, etc.) will only be
accepted for one week after the due date. Each day it is late, will result
in points deduction. *See absences below, those do NOT get points
deducted, as long as the timeline is followed.

Assignments/Projects:

• Late work for these assignments will only be accepted until that chapter is going to be tested and it will only receive partial credit. Students will always know when there is an assessment, so it is important that they keep that 'deadline' in mind.

Absences:

- If a student is absent, they have the same number of days that they were absent to get caught up on assignments. Ex: if they are absent for 2 days, the assignments/homework are due within the 2 days they return.
- I post most handouts and copies of notes in google classroom, so that is a great resource. I always encourage students to look there, especially if they need another copy of an assignment.

How can you help?

- Check Aeries a few times a week to see if your child has any assignments that are missing, better yet, have them look at it with you!
- Check their planner nightly or the digital planner that is on the class website www.tinyurl.com/mowerymagnolia
- Send me an email if there are special circumstances, I know life happens.
- Encourage your child to communicate with me that they need more time (This doesn't mean they will get a 'free' pass, but it makes them responsible for their work.) They will need to advocate for themselves next year injunior high and most teachers grade down for late submissions, regardless of the reason.

This has all been explained to your child, so it is not new to them.
