What an amazing summer of sunshine! The trees in the orchard are teeming with fruit, and with everything being so early this year, there will definitely be a lot to pick in the next couple of months..

First we'll need to get the orchard in shape - anyone who has passed through there recently will know it's in need of some tidying! Tomas says: Another grass / hogweed cutting session would be very helpful, and will also help with making a start on reducing future weed growing

**Sunday 7th September, 2-4pm, Mowing and cutting** - with a lot of grass to cut, it would be great to see quite a few people there. **Please bring (if you have them) scythes and sickles, secateurs, loppers, pruning saws (just in case), and wear gloves and boots (and trousers)**

**Saturday 11 / Sunday 12 October (tbc) Apple picking & pressing** - do you have a preference for the date? Hope a few more people come this year than last year. Please bring bottles.

**Saturday 18th October Leominster Apple Fair** - look out for more information around Leominster, coming soon.

**Saturday 1st November Spring Bulb Planting** - traditionally Samhain (pronounced Sawane) was the start of the pagan (meaning peasant) yearly cycle, which makes sense as it's a great time to get spring bulbs in the ground! BYOB (bring spring bulbs, pref native!)
