

RESPONSIVE READING REVELATION 19

There are at least 600 references to worship in the Bible,
using at least 87 different Hebrew and Greek words.

Psalms 134:2 lift up our hands

John 4:24 Biblical truths make us free to worship the Holy properly in spirit!

John 8:31-32 continue in His Word He is truth personified.

Psalms 100:4 enter into His courts with thanksgiving, praises, and blessings

Psalms 63:1 seek early, be thirsty for Him in this barren dry land we live

Psalms 134:2 don't be ashamed of lifting hands

Psalms 119:48 lift hands and meditate on the statutes

Hebrews 12:12 lift up those who are having a hard time to praise the Lord, hands that hang down; today
worship, and everyday! Don't rely on yesterday's manna...

Luke 17:12-19 Where are the other 9? Praise and thank immediately, as did the Samaritan.

Psalms 42:7 deep calleth unto deep...the heart of God to the heart of man

Hebrews 12:2 Expect Him to show up when you really worship

Job 38:4-7 God asks the same questions of us...

Luke 19:37-40 When the spirit moves, it can be loud & joyful

Psalms 72:18-19 All creation stands as an eyewitness to God's glory

Revelation 5:13 every creature everywhere! Our praise is very personal as children of the most High.

Revelation 4:8-11 praise is continuous; created for His pleasure. When we worship, we join the angels!

Psalms 8:1-2 worship is a 2 way street...we make contact with Him, and He blesses us.

James 4:7 Draw near and so will He. Submit to God. Resist the devil! We need to do both.

Psalms 8:1-2 His grandeur is over all and even the child knows praise stops the enemy in his tracks!

Philippians 2:10-11 all people will bow to Jesus.

Matthew 21:15-16 True worship begins in the heart. He wants worshippers BEFORE workers!

Psalms 51:17 broken spirit and heart before Him

Isaiah 57:15 God dwells in the high and holy place and if we are contrite (crushed before Him due to our
sins and transgressions before him, down, ready to give all to Him), we can be there, too....

Psalms 95:6 worship and bow down.... Be lowly and humble before Him; acknowledge His Lordship

Psalms 100:4 Enter His presence with thanksgiving, praise, and blessings towards Him.
