What will I need to fill out the FAFSA?

- An FSA ID to sign electronically
- Your Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- If you are a dependent student, then you will also need most of the above information for your parent(s).

- -Gain access to a large source of funding that may not be available through FAFSA alone.
- -Allows you to provide a more thorough picture of your family's finances than the FAFSA allows and explain special circumstances that your family may be experiencing.
- -Fee for initial application and one college report is \$25. Additional reports are \$16.

- -Reports are sent to colleges immediately upon payment.
