The Naturopathic Doctor reports directly to the President and serves as a core member of the medical team at Radiant Health Natural Medical Center. This role is focused on providing exceptional patient-centered care rooted in natural and holistic therapies, while contributing to the mission of Radiant Health through integrative, collaborative practice.

Summary

The essential responsibilities of this position are:

 2. Conduct thorough health assessments and consultations rooted in functional and naturopathic medicine
 3. Develop and implement comprehensive, patient-centered treatment plans
 4. Support ongoing collaboration within the clinic team to ensure integrative and coordinated care
 5. Engage in community health initiatives aligned with Radiant Health's mission and non-profit efforts
 6. Maintain professional standards of care, documentation, and ongoing education.
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Responsibilities of this Position

Deliver Individualized Naturopathic Care

- Conduct comprehensive health assessments and in-depth intake consultations;
- Utilize natural therapies including nutrition, lifestyle counseling, botanical medicine, homeopathy, and IV therapy
- Order and interpret laboratory and diagnostic testing as appropriate to guide treatment plans
- Provide compassionate, holistic care that empowers patients toward optimal wellness
- Prescribe natural and integrative therapies within licensure and clinic scope

Develop and Implement Treatment Plans

- Design personalized care plans based on patient goals, health history, and diagnostic results
- Educate patients on natural health principles and preventive strategies
- Adjust and refine care plans in response to patient progress and evolving needs
- Refer to other health practitioners when integrative support is needed.

Support Integrative and Collaborative Care

- Participate in weekly practitioner meetings to ensure cohesive, whole-person care
- Communicate effectively with the RH team to align care goals and outcomes
- Contribute to a team culture focused on collaboration, excellence, and patient empowerment

Engage in Community Health Initiatives

- Support workshops, events, and educational programs as needed
- Participate in outreach efforts and community gatherings to promote holistic health
- Represent RH's mission and values in all patient and public interactions

Maintain Professional Standards

- Maintain accurate, timely clinical documentation and treatment notes
- Stay current on developments in naturopathic and functional medicine
- Uphold all licensing, continuing education, and ethical standards as required
- Actively contribute to improving clinic processes, systems, and patient care models.

Requirements

- Graduate of an accredited naturopathic medical school (ND/NMD degree)
 - Licensed Naturopathic Doctor (or ability to obtain licensure if applicable)
 - 2+ years clinical experience preferred
 - Strong background in herbalism, homeopathy, functional medicine, botanical medicine, and holistic care. Hydrotherapy and/or Sports Medicine a plus
 - Commitment to natural, patient-centered healing
 - Excellent communication, collaboration, and documentation skills
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
